# Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

The Third Sunday of Advent is traditionally referred to as *Gaudete* Sunday. *Gaudete* means "rejoice", and it comes from the Latin translation of the first word for the introit of today's Mass, which is taken from the fourth chapter of the Letter of St. Paul to the Philippians (4:4-5). We rejoice as we wait for the joyful celebration of the Lord's birth and glorious Second Coming.

In today's Gospel, Christ amplifies this joy when he tells us that "among those born of women there has been none greater than John the Baptist; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he". This is a cause for great joy, brothers and sisters. We are on a pilgrimage to God's kingdom. Our guide for the way is the One Whom we expect, our Savior Jesus Christ, who is the Word made flesh. We would do well to listen to his words.

As we continue our *Conversations with the Saints* series, let us reflect on the following excerpts from St. Augustine's wordplay on the relationship between the *voice* and the *word* as it relates to Jesus and John the Baptist. "John is the voice, but the Lord *is the Word who was in the beginning*. John is the voice that lasts for a time; from the beginning Christ is the Word who lives forever".

St. Augustine further noted that "Because it is hard to distinguish word from voice, even John himself was thought to be the Christ. The voice was thought to be the word. But the voice acknowledged what it was, anxious not to give offense to the word. I am not the Christ, he said, nor Elijah, nor the prophet. And the question came: Who are you, then? He replied: I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness: Prepare the way for the Lord. The voice of one crying in the wilderness is the voice of one breaking the silence. Prepare the way for the Lord, he says, as though he were saying: "I speak out in order to lead him into your hearts, but he does not choose to come where I lead him unless you prepare the way for him."

In conclusion, St. Augustine shows us how to joyfully prepare for the coming of the Lord: "To prepare the way means to pray well; it means thinking humbly of oneself. We should take our lesson from John the Baptist. He is thought to be the Christ; he declares he is not what they think. He does not take advantage of their mistake to further his own glory." May we always wait patiently and with humility and joy for the coming of the Lord. Amen!

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

# Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

El tercer domingo de Adviento se conoce tradicionalmente como domingo de Gaudete. Gaudete significa "alegrarse", y proviene de la traducción latina de la primera palabra del introito de la Misa de hoy, que está tomada del cuarto capítulo de la Carta de San Pablo a los Filipenses (4,4-5). Nos regocijamos mientras esperamos la gozosa celebración del nacimiento del Señor y la gloriosa Segunda Venida.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Cristo amplifica esta alegría cuando nos dice que "entre los nacidos de mujer no ha habido ninguno mayor que Juan el Bautista; pero el más pequeño en el reino de los cielos es mayor que él". Esto es motivo de gran alegría, hermanos y hermanas. Estamos en una peregrinación al reino de Dios. Nuestro guía de camino es Aquel a Quien esperamos, nuestro Salvador Jesucristo, que es el Verbo hecho carne. Haríamos bien en escuchar sus palabras.

A medida que continuamos con nuestra serie *Conversaciones con los Santos*, reflexionemos sobre los siguientes extractos del juego de palabras de San Agustín sobre la relación entre la **voz** y la **palabra** en relación con Jesús y Juan el Bautista. "Juan es la voz, pero *el Señor es la Palabra que estaba en el principio*. Juan es la voz que dura un tiempo; desde el principio Cristo es la Palabra que vive para siempre".

San Agustín señaló además que "Debido a que es difícil distinguir la palabra de la voz, se pensó que incluso el mismo Juan era el Cristo. Se pensaba que la voz era la palabra. Pero la voz reconoció lo que era, ansiosa de no ofender la palabra. Yo no soy el Cristo, dijo, ni Elías, ni el profeta. Y vino la pregunta: ¿Quién eres, entonces? Él respondió: Soy la voz del que clama en el desierto: Preparad el camino para el Señor. La voz del que clama en el desierto es la voz del que rompe el silencio. Preparad el camino del Señor, dice, como si dijera: "Yo hablo para llevarlo a vuestros corazones, pero él no quiere ir adonde yo le conduzco a menos que vosotros le preparéis el camino".

En conclusión, San Agustín nos muestra cómo prepararnos con alegría para la venida del Señor: "Preparar el camino significa orar bien; significa pensar humildemente en uno mismo. Debemos tomar nuestra lección de Juan el Bautista. Se cree que es el Cristo; declara que no es lo que ellos piensan. Él no se aprovecha de su error para promover su propia gloria". Que siempre esperemos con paciencia y humildad y alegría la venida del Señor. ¡Amén!

Somos una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!



Many people have the mistaken notion that you are required to have some type of "professional training". (This is not the


You also don't necessarily have to stand up at the mic "all alone"; we have the possibility of using "duet" (two) cantors.
