Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today we celebrate the Feast of the **Epiphany** of the Lord. Jesus Christ is made manifest as the light of the nations. In today's Gospel, Magi from the East are led to Christ by the guidance of a star: "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage", they inquired when they made their way to Jerusalem. It was a common ancient belief to associate the birth of a ruler with the appearing of a new star!

Regardless of this ancient belief, there is a deeper meaning here for all. Christ is the Light of the world. Therefore, astrology and all other forms of divinations and fortune reading are hereby made obsolete and redundant. Only those who let Christ be the light of their life will find meaning and fulfillment in life. Christ himself reminds us of this truth when he said: "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (see: John 8:12).

Today, many dabble into various forms of fortune telling and divinations for divergent reasons. Not only are these sinful in that they are manifestations of a lack of trust in Divine providence but often times, they involve some form of dabbling with demonic entities that could invariably cause harm.

As such, the Church strongly caution that "All forms of divination are to be rejected: recourse to Satan or demons, conjuring up the dead or other practices falsely supposed to "unveil" the future. Consulting horoscopes, astrology, palm reading, interpretation of omens and lots, the phenomena of clairvoyance, and recourse to mediums all conceal a desire for power over time, history, and, in the last analysis, other human beings, as well as a wish to conciliate hidden powers. They contradict the honor, respect, and loving fear that we owe to God alone" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2116). We are to look to Jesus instead and trust that he will lead us aright in the journey of life!

Some people may have unwittingly dabbled into divination, fortune telling or participated in activities such as the Ouija board game, Charlie Charlie, etc. These are potentially harmful as they could serve as doorways to demonic influences. If this pertains to you or someone you know, please contact me or any of my brother priests for assistance. Remember, Christ is our Light who drives away the power of darkness. Be not afraid but trust in God!

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

Hoy celebramos la Fiesta de la Epifanía del **Señor**. Jesucristo se manifiesta como la luz de las naciones. En el evangelio de hoy, unos magos de Oriente son guiados hacia Cristo guiados por una estrella: "¿Donde está el rey de los judíos recién nacido? Vimos su estrella en su salida y hemos venido a rendirle homenaje", preguntaron cuando se dirigían a Jerusalén. ¡Era una creencia antigua común asociar el nacimiento de un gobernante con aparición de una nueva Independientemente de esta antigua creencia, aquí hay un significado más profundo para todos. Cristo es la Luz del mundo. Por lo tanto, la astrología y todas las demás formas de adivinación y lectura de la fortuna quedan obsoletas y redundantes. Sólo aquellos que dejan que Cristo sea la luz de su vida encontrarán sentido y plenitud en la vida. Cristo mismo nos recuerda esta verdad cuando dijo: "Yo soy la luz del mundo. El que me sigue, nunca andará en tinieblas, sino que tendrá la luz de la vida" (ver: Juan 8:12).

Hoy en día, muchos incursionan en diversas formas de adivinación y adivinación por razones divergentes. Estos no solo son pecaminosos en el sentido de que son manifestaciones de una falta de confianza en la providencia divina, sino que a menudo implican alguna forma de incursionar con entidades demoníacas que invariablemente podrían causar daño.

Como tal, la Iglesia advierte enfáticamente que "todas las formas de adivinación deben ser rechazadas: el recurso a Satanás oa los demonios. la invocación de muertos u otras prácticas que supuestamente "revelan" el futuro. La consulta de horóscopos, la astrología, la lectura de la palma de la mano, la interpretación de presagios y sorteos, los fenómenos de la videncia y el recurso a los médiums ocultan un deseo de poder sobre el tiempo, la historia y, en última instancia, sobre otros seres humanos, así como un deseo para conciliar poderes ocultos. Contradicen el honor, el respeto y el temor amoroso que debemos sólo a Dios" (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, 2116). ¡Debemos mirar a Jesús y confiar en que él nos guiará correctamente en el camino de la vida!

Algunas personas pueden haber incursionado sin darse cuenta en la adivinación, la adivinación o haber participado en actividades como el juego de mesa Ouija, Charlie Charlie, etc. Estas son potencialmente dañinas ya que podrían servir como puertas de entrada a las influencias demoníacas. Si esto le pertenece a usted o a alguien que conoce, comuníquese conmigo o con cualquiera de mis hermanos sacerdotes para obtener ayuda. Recuerda, Cristo es nuestra Luz que ahuyenta el poder de las tinieblas. ¡No temas sino confía en Dios!




