Dearly Beloved in Christ:

St. Thomas Aquinas described truth as "the conformity of the mind with reality". Thus, to profess truth is to be in agreement with reality. As Creator of all there is, God is the Ground and Ultimate Source of truth. God is truth.

Humans do not necessarily create truth; rather, we come to discover what is true. In our world today, this truth has been distorted by the error of relativism, which holds that truth is whatever one decides it to be. Not only does relativism logically contradict itself, but it also continues to lead many to adopt an erroneous way of life. We live in truth when we strive to follow Christ who is "the way, the truth and the life". Relativism, just like the sinister suggestion of the tempter in the Garden of Eden (see: **Genesis 3:1-7**), invites us to abandon God as the source of truth and to replace God with our own imperfect judgment. Only disaster, chaos and destruction come when we abandon God!

To understand this basic truth is to gain a keen insight into how evil thrives on the distortion of truth. Take the issue of the dignity and sanctity of ALL human life for instance. Our faith clearly teaches us that all human life, from natural conception to natural death, is sacred and inviolable because God is the source of life. Here are a few examples of how evil seeks to distort this truth: through abortion, which sees the child in the womb as "less" human and so dispensable; through institutional racism, which judges that some humans are better and more deserving than others; through the pornography industry, prostitution, and human trafficking, which strips people of their dignity, and exploits them as "things" to be commercialized.

All humans are created in the image and likeness of God; re-created through the Life, Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ; and endowed with the Holy Spirit as "the first installment of our inheritance toward redemption as God's possession, to the praise of his glory" (Cf. **Ephesians 1:13-14**). Herein lies the truth and the source of all human dignity.

As God's children, let us live in truth. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to help us discern the twisted lies of the devil, who is the father of all lies (see: **John 8:44**), to reject these lies, and to follow God faithfully all the days of our life. Amen! See **page 11** for some suggestions on how to celebrate and promote human life in truth.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

Santo Tomás de Aquino describió la verdad como "la conformidad de la mente con la realidad". Así, profesar la verdad es estar de acuerdo con la realidad. Como Creador de todo lo que existe, Dios es el Fundamento y la Fuente Última de la verdad. Dios es la verdad.

Los humanos no necesariamente crean la verdad; más bien, venimos a descubrir lo que es verdad. En nuestro mundo actual, esta verdad ha sido distorsionada por el error del relativismo, que sostiene que la verdad es lo que uno decida que El relativismo no solo se contradice sea. lógicamente a sí mismo, sino que continúa llevando a muchos a adoptar una forma de vida errónea. Vivimos en la verdad cuando nos esforzamos por seguir a Cristo que es "el camino, la verdad y la vida". El relativismo, al igual que la siniestra sugerencia del tentador en el Jardín del Edén (ver: **Génesis 3:1-7**), nos invita a abandonar a Dios como fuente de la verdad y reemplazar a Dios con nuestro propio juicio imperfecto. ¡Solo el desastre, el caos y la destrucción vienen cuando abandonamos a Dios!

Comprender esta verdad básica es obtener una visión profunda de cómo el mal se nutre de la distorsión de la verdad. Tome el tema de la dignidad y la santidad de TODA vida humana, por ejemplo. Nuestra fe nos enseña claramente que toda vida humana, desde la concepción natural hasta la muerte natural, es sagrada e inviolable porque Dios es la fuente de la vida. Aquí hay algunos ejemplos de cómo el mal busca distorsionar esta verdad: a través del aborto, que ve al niño en el útero como "menos" humano y tan prescindible; a través del racismo institucional, que juzga que algunos humanos son mejores y más merecedores que otros; a través de la industria de la pornografía, la prostitución y la trata de personas, que despoja a las personas de su dignidad y las explota como "cosas" para comercializar.

Todos los humanos son creados a imagen y semejanza de Dios; recreado por la Vida, Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección de nuestro Señor Jesucristo; y dotados del Espíritu Santo como "primicia de nuestra herencia para la redención como posesión de Dios, para alabanza de su gloria" (cf. **Efesios 1, 13-14**). Aquí está la verdad y la fuente de toda dignidad humana.

Como hijos de Dios, vivamos en la verdad. Pidámosle al Espíritu Santo que nos ayude a discernir las mentiras torcidas del diablo, que es el padre de todas las mentiras (ver: **Juan 8:44**), para rechazar estas mentiras y seguir fielmente a Dios todos los días de nuestra vida. ¡Amén! Vea la **página 11** para algunas sugerencias sobre cómo celebrar y promover la vida humana en la verdad.

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!


