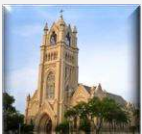

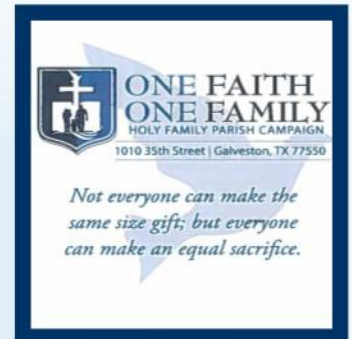

## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Once again, we are all invited to pause for a moment and reflect on the contributions and achievements of Catholic Education in the society as we celebrate **National Catholic Schools Week (January 27 – February 3)**.
