Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

It's Super Bowl weekend! By the end of the day, a champion will emerge and most of us would become a few pounds heavier as well! As many celebrate joyfully the victory of their triumphant team and athletes, others would wince in pain or simply remain apathetic to the outcome of the game.

The physical attributes and skills of athletes often leave an impression on us. Occasionally, they may even inspire us to become more intentional about our physical wellbeing. Saint Paul invites us to learn an even more important lesson from the athletes. In his First Letter to the Corinthian community, he admonishes us to imitate their discipline in our efforts to secure our salvation, relying on the graces of God of course: "Every athlete exercises discipline in every way. They do it to win a perishable crown, but we an imperishable one. Thus I do not run aimlessly; I do not fight as if I were shadowboxing. No, I drive my body and train it, for fear that, after having preached to others, I myself should be disqualified" (1 Corinthians 9:25-27).

Physical exercise is profitable, for sure, but it has its place. As Saint Paul reminds us, the body is the temple of the Holy Spirit (see **1 Corinthians 6:19**). So, taking good care of the body with the understanding that we belong to God and are to offer ourselves as a living sacrifice to God, not in accordance with the standards of the world but in line with God's will (cf. **Roman 12:1-2**) is certainly a good thing. Many approach exercising, motivated but all sorts of vain reasons; this should not be the way of a believer. As disciples, we are called to use our bodies as instruments of righteousness and not of iniquity.

Again, Saint Paul would reminds us that "while physical training is of limited value, devotion is valuable in every respect, since it holds a promise of life both for the present and for the future" (1 **Timothy 4:8**). Our world today places great emphasis on physical appearance and wellbeing. In addition to working on our physical health, let us not neglect the spiritual wellbeing of our souls.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Los atributos físicos y las habilidades de los atletas a menudo nos dejan una impresión. De vez en cuando, incluso pueden inspirarnos a ser más intencionales con respecto a nuestro bienestar físico. San Pablo nos invita a aprender una lección aún más importante de los atletas. En su Primera Carta a la comunidad de Corinto, nos exhorta a imitar su disciplina en nuestros esfuerzos por asegurar nuestra salvación, confiando por supuesto en las gracias de Dios: "Todo atleta ejerce disciplina en todos los sentidos. Ellos lo hacen para ganar una corona perecedera, pero nosotros una imperecedera. Así no corro sin rumbo fijo; Yo no peleo como si fuera boxeador de sombras. Antes bien, conduzco mi cuerpo y lo entreno, por temor de que, después de haber predicado a otros, yo mismo quede descalificado" (1 Corintios **9:25-27**).

El ejercicio físico es rentable, seguro, pero tiene su sitio. Como nos recuerda san Pablo, el cuerpo es templo del Espíritu Santo (cf. 1 Corintios 6,19). Por lo tanto, cuidar bien el cuerpo entendiendo que pertenecemos a Dios y debemos ofrecernos como sacrificio vivo a Dios, no según las normas del mundo, sino según la voluntad de Dios (cf. **Romanos 12:1**). -2) es ciertamente algo bueno. Muchos se acercan al ejercicio, motivados pero por todo tipo de razones vanas; este no debe ser el camino de un creyente. Como discípulos, estamos llamados a usar nuestros cuerpos como instrumentos de justicia y no de iniquidad.

Nuevamente, San Pablo nos recordaría que "mientras que el entrenamiento físico tiene un valor limitado, la devoción es valiosa en todos los aspectos, ya que encierra una promesa de vida tanto para el presente como para el futuro" (**1 Timoteo 4: 8**). Nuestro mundo actual pone gran énfasis en la apariencia física y el bienestar. Además de trabajar en nuestra salud física, no descuidemos el bienestar espiritual de nuestras almas.
