Why Does Holy Family Need a New Parish Life Center?

Here are the main issues we are working to resolve:

- Our 40-plus ministries are trying to plan and perform parish and community outreach from one large room and a handful of small rooms on the St. Patrick's campus, and very few of those are ADA compliant. Routinely, two, even three ministries are meeting at the same time in the same limited area, making it difficult to hear, discuss and conduct business.
- Last year, our parish volunteers logged more than 33,000 hours in gifts of time. Where to put these dedicated volunteers? Where to provide an adequate work space? And, where to park?
- Masses, funeral services, wedding planning and other imperative church activities often intersect with "parish life" ministries, competing for space and time.
- All our current available meeting spaces are in sub-par facilities, and we believe our hard-working ministries and our parish staff deserve nice, appealing and accommodating facilities.

And here's what our \$5.5M capital campaign—when completed—will achieve for Holy Family Parish:

- A beautiful restored facility, centrally located at Holy Family Parish Catholic School, featuring 14,000 square feet of space to house ministry and community rooms as well as new parish offices, all on one floor! The space will be fully ADA compliant and parking will be ample and well-lit.
- Holy Family's new Parish Life Center will be convenient and available to all.
- Most importantly, it will present our parish as the growing, thriving and dynamic headquarters for Catholic worship, education and outreach that it is!

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

In a few days we will celebrate **Ash Wednesday**, which marks the beginning of the holy **Season of Lent**. See **p. 11** for the full schedule. On Ash Wednesday, many of us will receive ashes on our forehead. Let us pause for a moment and reflect on the significance of this rich ritual act.

So, why get ashes on our forehead? Didn't Jesus say that we should "take care not to perform righteous deeds in order that people may see them; otherwise, you will have no recompense from your heavenly Father"? (See **Matthew 6:1**). Therefore, is getting ashes contrary to Jesus' advice? Are we running the risk of *parading our good works for all to see* when we get ashes?

On the contrary, when we receive ashes on our forehead, we are essentially making a commitment to follow the Lord more intently especially through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The ashes signify our intention, but it would be useless if we do not follow through with our actions. The ashes will last but for one day; the actions we take to help us turn away from sin and evil so as to follow the Lord more closely and to love our neighbors should endure.

So, it is certainly good to receive ashes on our foreheads as long as we are not simply content with just getting our forehead smeared with ashes but are willing to follow through with the commitment they signify. And yes, Jesus actually encourages us to let our good works be visible before others, to the glory of God: "your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father" (**Matthew 5:16**).

We invite you to embrace this holy season of Lent with an open heart. Invite your family and friends to the spiritual activities that we will be offering this Lent, starting with the **Parish Lenten Retreat** (from Monday, February 27 to Wednesday, March 1). In addition, we will continue with our **Dialogues with the Saints** series in the bulletin, through which we reflect prayerfully with the saints on the holy season of Lent; throughout Lent we will have the Stations of the Cross on Fridays both in English and in Spanish; and do not forget about the weekly exposition and adoration of the Eucharist in the chapel. You can find more information about all of this in this bulletin.

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

Dentro de unos días celebraremos el **Miércoles de Ceniza**, que marca el inicio del **tiempo santo de Cuaresma**. Ver pág. 11 para el horario completo. El Miércoles de Ceniza, muchos de nosotros recibiremos cenizas en la frente. Detengámonos un momento y reflexionemos sobre el significado de este rico acto ritual.

Entonces, ¿por qué ponernos cenizas en la frente? ¿No dijo Jesús que debemos "cuidarnos de hacer obras justas para que la gente las vea; de lo contrario, no tendréis recompensa de vuestro Padre celestial"? (Ver **Mateo 6:1**). Por lo tanto, ¿obtener cenizas es contrario al consejo de Jesús? ¿Corremos el riesgo de exhibir nuestras buenas obras a la vista de todos cuando nos quedemos cenizas?

Por el contrario, cuando recibimos cenizas en nuestra frente, esencialmente nos comprometemos a seguir al Señor más intensamente, especialmente a través de la oración, el ayuno y la limosna. Las cenizas significan nuestra intención, pero de nada serviría si no cumplimos con nuestras acciones. Las cenizas durarán solo un día; las acciones que tomamos para ayudarnos a alejarnos del pecado y del mal para seguir más de cerca al Señor y amar a nuestro prójimo deben perdurar.

Por lo tanto, ciertamente es bueno recibir cenizas en la frente, siempre y cuando no estemos contentos con mancharnos la frente con cenizas, sino que estemos dispuestos a cumplir con el compromiso que significan. Y sí, Jesús en realidad nos anima a dejar que nuestras buenas obras sean visibles ante los demás, para la gloria de Dios: "su luz debe brillar ante los demás, para que vean sus buenas obras y glorifiquen a su Padre celestial" (**Mateo 5:16**).

Te invitamos a abrazar esta santa temporada de Cuaresma con un corazón abierto. Invita a tus familiares y amigos a las actividades espirituales que estaremos ofreciendo esta Cuaresma, comenzando con el **Retiro Parroquial de Cuaresma** (del lunes 27 de febrero al miércoles 1 de marzo). Además, continuaremos con nuestra serie **Diálogos con los Santos** en el boletín, a través de la cual reflexionamos en oración con los santos sobre el tiempo santo de Cuaresma; durante la Cuaresma tendremos las Estaciones de la Cruz los viernes tanto en inglés como en español; y no te olvides de la exposición y adoración semanal de la Eucaristía en la capilla. Puedes encontrar más información sobre todo esto en este boletín.





LENT IS COMING!


