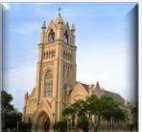

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Our **Conversations with the Saints** series this week focuses on St. Augustine's treatise on the *Woman at the Well* -

"A woman came. She is a symbol of the Church not yet made righteous but about to be made righteous. Righteousness follows from the conversation. She came in ignorance, she found Christ, and he enters into conversation with her.... The Samaritans did not form part of the Jewish people: they were foreigners. The fact that she came from a foreign people is part of the symbolic meaning, for she is a symbol of the Church. The Church was to come from the Gentiles, of a different race from the Jews.

We must then recognize ourselves in her words and in her person, and with her give our own thanks to God. ...Jesus says to her: *Give me water to drink. For his disciples had gone to the city to buy food. The Samaritan woman therefore says to him: How is it that you, though a Jew, ask me for water to drink, though I am a Samaritan woman? For Jews have nothing to do with Samaritans.*

The Samaritans were foreigners; Jews never used their utensils. The woman was carrying a pail for drawing water. She was astonished that a Jew should ask her for a drink of water, a thing that Jews would not do. But the one who was asking for a drink of water was thirsting for her faith.

Listen now and learn who it is that asks for a drink. *Jesus answered her and said: If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, "Give me a drink," perhaps you might have asked him and he would have given you living water.*

He asks for a drink, and he promises a drink. He is in need, as one hoping to receive, yet he is rich, as one about to satisfy the thirst of others. He says: *If you knew the gift of God.* The gift of God is the Holy Spirit. But he is still using veiled language as he speaks to the woman and gradually enters into her heart. Or is he already teaching her? What could be more gentle and kind than the encouragement he gives? *If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, "Give me a drink," perhaps you might ask and he would give you living water....*

He was promising the Holy Spirit in satisfying abundance. She did not yet understand.... If only she could hear those words: *Come to me, all who labor and are burdened, and I will refresh you.* Jesus was saying this to her, so that her labors might be at an end; but she was not yet able to understand."

We are one **Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo;

Nuestra serie, **Conversaciones con los Santos**, de esta semana se centran en el tratado de San Agustín sobre la mujer junto al pozo -

Llega una mujer. Se trata aquí de una figura de la Iglesia, no santa aún, pero sí a punto de serlo; de esto, en efecto, habla nuestra lectura. La mujer llegó sin saber nada, encontró a Jesús, y él se puso a hablar con ella. ... Los samaritanos no tenían nada que ver con los judíos; no eran del pueblo elegido. Y esto ya significa algo: aquella mujer, que representaba a la Iglesia, era una extranjera, porque la Iglesia iba a ser constituida por gente extraña al pueblo de Israel.

Pensemos, pues, que aquí se está hablando ya de nosotros: reconozcámonos en la mujer, y, como incluidos en ella, demos gracias a Dios. ... Jesús le dice: «Dame de beber». Sus discípulos se habían ido al pueblo a comprar comida. La samaritana le dice: ¿Cómo tú, siendo judío, me pides de beber a mí, que soy samaritana?" Porque los judíos no se tratan con los samaritanos.

Ved cómo se trata aquí de extranjeros: los judíos no querían ni siquiera usar sus vasijas. Y como aquella mujer llevaba una vasija para sacar el agua, se asombró de que un judío le pidiera de beber, pues no acostumbraban a hacer esto los judíos. Pero aquel que le pedía de beber tenía sed, en realidad, de la fe de aquella mujer.

Fíjate en quién era aquel que le pedía de beber: Jesús le contestó: «Si conocieras el don de Dios, y quién es el que te pide de beber, le pedirías tú, y él te daría agua viva.»

Le pedía de beber, y fue él mismo quien prometió darle el agua. Se presenta como quien tiene indigencia, como quien espera algo, y le promete abundancia, como quien está dispuesto a dar hasta la saciedad. Si conocieras —dice— el don de Dios. El don de Dios es el Espíritu Santo. A pesar de que no habla aún claramente a la mujer, ya va penetrando, poco a poco, en su corazón y ya la está adoctrinando. ¿Podría encontrarse algo más suave y más bondadoso que esta exhortación? Si conocieras el don de Dios, y quién es el que te pide de beber, le pedirías tú, y él te daría agua viva....

De manera que le estaba ofreciendo un manjar apetitoso y la saciedad del Espíritu Santo, pero ella no lo acababa de entender.... Ojalá hubiera podido escuchar: Venid a mi todos los que estáis cansados y agobiados, y yo os aliviaré. Esto era precisamente lo que Jesús quería darle a entender, para que no se sintiera ya agobiada; pero la mujer aún no lo entendía.

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**

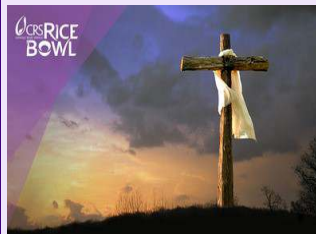

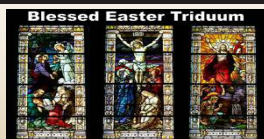

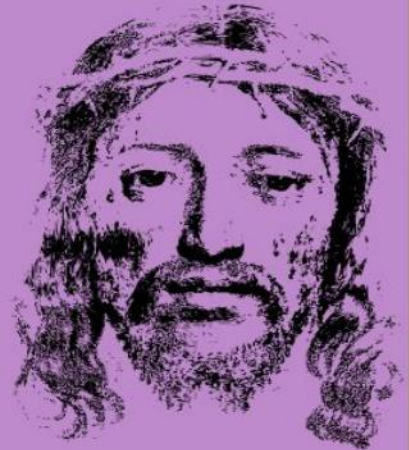
