Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Let us imitate the fortitude of the blind man in today's Gospel who, having been healed from both physical and spiritual blindness, faithfully followed Christ who is *the way, the truth and the life*. In our **Conversations with the Saints** series for this week, we listen to St. Augustine as he exhorts us to follow Christ faithfully.

"The Lord tells us: *I am the light of the world; he who follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life*. In these few words he gives a command and makes a promise. Let us do what he commands so that we may not blush to covet what he promises and to hear him say on the day of judgment: "I laid down certain conditions for obtaining my promises. Have you fulfilled them?" If you say: "What did you command, Lord our God?" he will tell you: "I commanded you to follow me. You asked for advice on how to enter into life. ...

Let us do now what he commands. Let us follow in the footsteps of the Lord. Let us throw off the chains that prevent us from following him. Who can throw off these shackles without the aid of the one addressed in these words: *You have broken my chains?* Another psalm says of him: *The Lord frees those in chains, the Lord raises up the downcast*.

Those who have been freed and raised up follow the light. The light they follow speaks to them: *I am the light of the world; he who follows me will not walk in darkness*. The Lord gives light to the blind. Brethren, that light shines on us now, for we have had our eyes anointed with the eye-salve of faith. His saliva was mixed with earth to anoint the man born blind. We are of Adam's stock, blind from our birth; we need him to give us light. He mixed saliva with earth, and so it was prophesied: *Truth has sprung up from the earth*. He himself has said: *I am the way, the truth, and the life*.

We shall be in possession of the truth when we see face to face. This is his promise to us. ...If you love me, follow me. "I do love you," you protest, "but how do I follow you?" If the Lord your God said to you: "I am the truth and the life," in your desire for truth, in your love for life, you would certainly ask him to show you the way to reach them. You would say to yourself: "Truth is a great reality, life is a great reality; if only it were possible for my soul to find them!"

We are one **Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo;

Imitemos la fortaleza del ciego del Evangelio de hoy que, habiendo sido curado de la ceguera tanto física como espiritual, siguió fielmente a Cristo que es *el camino, la verdad y la vida*. En nuestra serie de **Conversaciones con los Santos** de esta semana, escuchamos a San Agustín mientras nos exhorta a seguir fielmente a Cristo.

"El Señor dijo concisamente: *Yo soy la luz del mundo: el que me sigue no camina en tinieblas, sino que tendrá la luz de la vida*. Con estas palabras nos mandó una cosa y nos prometió otra. Hagamos lo que nos mandó y, de esta forma, no desearemos de manera insolente lo que nos prometió; no sea que tenga que decirnos el día del juicio: «¿Hiciste lo que mandé, para poder pedirme ahora lo que prometí?» «¿Qué es lo que mandaste, Señor, Dios nuestro?» Te dice: «Que me siguieras.» Pediste un consejo de vida. ...

Conque hagámoslo ahora, sigamos al Señor; desatemos aquellas ataduras que nos impiden seguirlo. Pero ¿quién será capaz de desatar tales nudos, si no nos ayuda aquel mismo a quien se dijo: *Rompiste mis cadenas?* El mismo de quien en otro salmo se afirma: *El Señor liberta a los cautivos, el Señor endereza a los que ya se doblan*.

¿Y en pos de qué corren los liberados y los puestos en pie, sino de la luz de la que han oído: *Yo soy la luz del mundo: el que me sigue no camina en tinieblas?* Porque el Señor abre los ojos al ciego. Quedaremos iluminados, hermanos, si tenemos el colirio de la fe. Porque fue necesaria la saliva de Cristo mezclada con tierra para ungir al ciego de nacimiento. También nosotros hemos nacido ciegos por causa de Adán, y necesitamos que el Señor nos ilumine. Mezcló saliva con tierra; por ello está escrito: *La Palabra se hizo carne y acampó entre nosotros. Mezcló saliva con tierra, pues estaba también anunciado: La verdad brota de la tierra; y él mismo había dicho: Yo soy el camino, y la verdad, y la vida*.

Disfrutaremos de la verdad cuando lleguemos a verla cara a cara, pues también esto se nos promete. ...Si lo amas, síguelo. «Yo lo amo —me dices—, pero ¿por qué camino lo sigo?» Si el Señor, tu Dios, te hubiese dicho: «Yo soy la verdad y la vida», y tú deseases la verdad y anhelaras la vida, sin duda que hubieras preguntado por el camino para alcanzarlas, y te estarías diciendo: «Gran cosa es la verdad, gran cosa es la vida; ojalá mi alma tuviera la posibilidad de llegar hasta ellas.»

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**
