### Message from the Pastor

#### Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Destructis vinculis mortis, Chrisus ab inferis victor ascendit (Christ broke the prison-bars of death and rose victorious from the underworld); happy **Mercy Sunday!** This week, rather than a note from the Pastor, you get an announcement from the Parochial Vicar. I am beginning two new ministries here at the parish: a Book Club for Men and a Book Club for Women. This will be an opportunity for us to gather as Christ's faithful and seek to fall more in love with Him and His Church through reading and group discussion.

The basic idea behind the book club is that each group will meet every other week (I will rotate between the men's group and the women's group each week) to discuss the assigned reading material. I decided on separate groups for men and women, rather than just one big group, because each group will do different readings that will emphasize and focus on different things. For the men's group, our first assigned text will be *Into the Breach: An Apostolic Exhortation to Catholic Men* by Bishop Thomas Olmsted, the retired Bishop of Phoenix. For the women's group, our first text will be Pope St. John Paul II's Apostolic Letter *On the Dignity and Vocation of Women*. Both of these texts can be accessed online.

Community and fraternity are so important to the Christian life, and it is my hope that these book clubs will provide an opportunity to form greater communal bonds here at Holy Family Parish by providing an opportunity to gather together and talk about the faith. In addition to fostering community, these book clubs will hopefully be a means of falling more in love with Christ and living out a more faithful discipleship. The Catholic Church has an incredibly rich treasury of spiritual writings and through these book clubs we will begin opening and discussing some of them.

Whether you can come to every gathering, once in a while, or just one time, please consider joining our new book clubs. We will meet on Monday evenings at 7:00 in St. Patrick Room #2 and the start date for the men's group will be Monday, May 1 and for the women Monday, May 8. ### Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo;

Destructis vinculis mortis, Chrisus ab inferis victor ascendit (Cristo rompió los barrotes de la prisión de la muerte y se levantó victorioso del inframundo); ¡Feliz Domingo de la Misericordia! Esta semana, en lugar de una nota del Párroco, recibe un anuncio del Vicario Parroquial. Estoy comenzando dos nuevos ministerios aquí en la parroquia: un club de lectura para hombres y un club de lectura para mujeres. Esta será una oportunidad para que nos reunamos como fieles de Cristo y busquemos enamorarnos más de Él y de Su Iglesia a través de la lectura y la discusión en grupo.

La idea básica detrás del club de lectura es que cada grupo se reúna cada dos semanas (rotaré entre el grupo de hombres y el grupo de mujeres cada semana) para discutir el material de lectura asignado. Decidí grupos separados para hombres y mujeres, en lugar de un solo grupo grande, porque cada grupo hará diferentes lecturas que enfatizarán y se enfocarán en diferentes cosas. Para el grupo de hombres, nuestro primer texto asignado será Into the Breach: An Apostolic Exhortation to Catholic Men por el obispo Thomas Olmsted, el obispo jubilado de Phoenix. Para el grupo de mujeres, nuestro primer texto será la Carta Apostólica del Papa San Juan Pablo II sobre la dignidad y la vocación de la mujer. Se puede acceder a ambos textos en línea.

La comunidad y la fraternidad son muy importantes para la vida cristiana, y espero que estos clubes de lectura brinden la oportunidad de formar mayores lazos comunitarios aquí en la Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia al brindar la oportunidad de reunirse y hablar sobre la fe. Además de fomentar la comunidad, se espera que estos clubes de lectura sean un medio para enamorarse más de Cristo y vivir un discipulado más fiel. La Iglesia Católica tiene un tesoro increíblemente rico de escritos espirituales y a través de estos clubes de lectura comenzaremos a abrir y discutir algunos de ellos.

Ya sea que pueda asistir a todas las reuniones, de vez en cuando o solo una vez, considere unirse a nuestros nuevos clubes de lectura. Nos reuniremos los lunes por la noche a las 7:00 en la sala n.º 2 de St. Patrick y la fecha de inicio para el grupo de hombres será el lunes 1 de mayo y para las mujeres el lunes 8 de mayo. 

## Are You at Risk?

Stroke Scan, Plus will host a stroke and vascular ultrasound screening here at Holy Family (St. Patrick) Mon & Tues April 24 & 25. Morning and afternoon appointments will be available to accommodate most working schedules. Serious diseases have been identified through this process at this parish in the past so please give it your attention.

Do you have high blood pressure or high cholesterol? Do you have a family history of heart disease, stroke, or diabetes? If any of these are true, do not miss this opportunity for early detection of a possible serious disease.


