# Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

As I reflect on the progresses we continue to make in our ongoing Capital Campaign, I am grateful to God for His blessings to our parish! Less than two years ago, we kicked off our campaign to raise \$5.5 million for the first Phase of our campaign to create a centrally located parish life center. Today, we have exceeded 50 % both in pledges and in cash redeemed. Thank you for your amazing generosity!

On Monday, May 1<sup>st</sup> – which is also the **feast** of St. Joseph the Worker – we hit another milestone in our campaign efforts as on that day, we will have the official **groundbreaking ceremony** for our project. Everyone is invited! The ceremony will kick off at 6PM at the school (2601 Ursuline Street, Galveston). Cardinal DiNardo will be our special guest of honor at the groundbreaking ceremony.

The Psalmist reminds us that "if the Lord does not build the house, in vain do the builders build" (see: Psalm 127:1). We are grateful to God for his blessings to our campaign efforts thus far, and we urge you all to pray earnestly for its ongoing success. What we are building, with the help of God, is a gathering space for all.

And how providential it is that our current school grounds will serve as the location for this. It is as though the Lord is inviting us to continue to keep our children central in our parish family! The Ursuline nuns who graced the shores of Galveston in 1847 did just that in establishing the Ursuline Academy, which over the years has now been transformed into our own Holy Family Catholic School. As we accomplish our campaign goals therefore, we are in essence furthering the beautiful work that these courageous nuns began 175 years ago, even as we provide for our wider parish needs.

The month of April is also Child Abuse Prevention Month. We know from the Gospel accounts that Christ really loves children. He admonished his disciples to imitate their innocence and humility (see: Matthew 18:1-5), as well as welcome them in the community of believers (Matthew 19:13-15). CASA, which stands for Court Special Advocate, Appointed is organization that trains volunteers who appointed by a judge to serve as an advocate for children who are experiencing abuses in the foster care system. 




