Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Happy Pentecost Sunday! Together with the Psalmist, we joyfully pray: "Lord, send forth your spirit and renew the face of the earth!" (cf. **Psalm 104:30**). The Holy Spirit, the Paraclete, is the one who responds to the cry of the children of God, for "the Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness" (see: **Romans 8:26**). Let us call on the Holy Spirit fervently to renew our hearts, our lives, our families, our communities, indeed the world!

It is only by the grace of the Holy Spirit that we can be effective disciples of Christ. St. Peter invites us to always "be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope" (**1 Peter 3:15**). Peter's speech on Pentecost day (see: **Acts 2:14-41**) did just that! Filled with the Holy Spirit, he gave witness to the new life we have in Christ. Those who heard him were so moved that they too became disciples of Christ. We are called to do the same, relying of course, on the graces of the Holy Spirit!

Faith in Christ is not a private affair! As disciples of Christ, we have been tasked to be *the light of the world and the salt of the earth*. It is not enough to be a 'good Christian'; we have to also stand with Christ in public places! We have to give witness to Christ in the world by our way of life. A disciple is to be bold, not arrogant; humble, not fearful; outspoken when it comes to the things of God, not timid or indifferent; and a conduit of God's love to the world.

Oftentimes Catholics. as we seem uncomfortable to speak about our faith or the things of God. This could be because we feel inadequate, want to be 'polite', or are simply unsure of what to say. Yet, as St. Peter exhorts us above, we have to be ready always to give an explanation for the reason for our hope and for our faith! To help us do this, we would like to invite you to participate in our new parish Faith Forum for adults, which we began about two weeks ago. This is a no-obligation, come-as-youare gathering for you to learn more about the Catholic faith, Tradition and practices. We meet every other Thursday of the month. Our first series will focus on the Marian Apparitions. See page 13 for more details.


