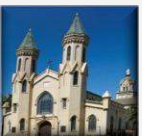

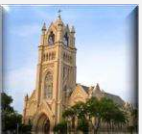

## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Happy Pentecost Sunday! Together with the Psalmist, we joyfully pray: "Lord, send forth your spirit and renew the face of the earth!" (cf. **Psalm 104:30**). The Holy Spirit, the Paraclete, is the one who responds to the cry of the children of God, for "the Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness" (see: **Romans 8:26**). Let us call on the Holy Spirit fervently to renew our hearts, our lives, our families, our communities, indeed the world!

It is only by the grace of the Holy Spirit that we can be effective disciples of Christ. St. Peter invites us to always "be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope" (**1 Peter 3:15**). Peter's speech on Pentecost day (see: **Acts 2:14-41**) did just that! Filled with the Holy Spirit, he gave witness to the new life we have in Christ. Those who heard him were so moved that they too became disciples of Christ. We are called to do the same, relying of course, on the graces of the Holy Spirit!

Faith in Christ is not a private affair! As disciples of Christ, we have been tasked to be *the light of the world and the salt of the earth*. It is not enough to be a 'good Christian'; we have to also stand with Christ in public places! We have to give witness to Christ in the world by our way of life. A disciple is to be bold, not arrogant; humble, not fearful; outspoken when it comes to the things of God, not timid or indifferent; and a conduit of God's love to the world.

Oftentimes as Catholics, we seem uncomfortable to speak about our faith or the things of God. This could be because we feel inadequate, want to be 'polite', or are simply unsure of what to say. Yet, as St. Peter exhorts us above, we *have to be ready always to give an explanation* for the reason for our hope and for our faith! To help us do this, we would like to invite you to participate in our new parish **Faith Forum** for adults, which we began about two weeks ago. This is a no-obligation, come-as-you-are gathering for you to learn more about the Catholic faith, Tradition and practices. We meet every other Thursday of the month. Our first series will focus on the Marian Apparitions. See **page 13** for more details.

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

## Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

¡Feliz Domingo de Pentecostés! Junto con el salmista, rezamos con alegría: "¡Señor, envía tu espíritu y renueva la faz de la tierra!" (cf. **Salmo 104:30**). El Espíritu Santo, el Paráclito, es quien responde al clamor de los hijos de Dios, porque "el Espíritu viene en ayuda de nuestra debilidad" (ver: **Rom 8,26**). Invoquemos fervientemente al Espíritu Santo para que renueve nuestros corazones, nuestras vidas, nuestras familias, nuestras comunidades, ¡incluso el mundo!

Es solo por la gracia del Espíritu Santo que podemos ser discípulos efectivos de Cristo. San Pedro nos invita a estar siempre "preparados para dar razón a cualquiera que os demande razón de vuestra esperanza" (**1 Pedro 3,15**). ¡El discurso de Pedro en el día de Pentecostés (ver: **Hechos 2:14-41**) hizo exactamente eso! Lleno del Espíritu Santo, dio testimonio de la vida nueva que tenemos en Cristo. Los que lo escucharon se conmovieron tanto que ellos también se convirtieron en discípulos de Cristo. ¡Estamos llamados a hacer lo mismo, confiando, por supuesto, en las gracias del Espíritu Santo!

¡La fe en Cristo no es un asunto privado! Como discípulos de Cristo, se nos ha encomendado ser *la luz del mundo y la sal de la tierra*. A menudo, como católicos, parece que nos sentimos incómodos al hablar de nuestra fe o de las cosas de Dios. Esto podría deberse a que nos sentimos inadecuados, queremos ser "educados" o simplemente no estamos seguros de qué decir. Sin embargo, como San Pedro nos exhorta más arriba, ¡tenemos que estar siempre dispuestos a dar una explicación de la razón de nuestra esperanza y de nuestra fe! Para ayudarnos a hacer esto, nos gustaría invitarlo a participar en nuestro nuevo **Foro Parroquial de Fe** para adultos, que comenzamos hace unas dos semanas. Esta es una reunión sin compromiso para que pueda aprender más sobre la fe, la tradición y las prácticas católicas. Nos reunimos cada dos jueves del mes. 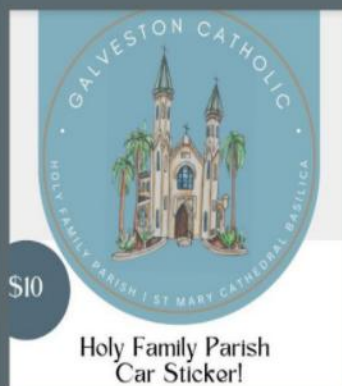

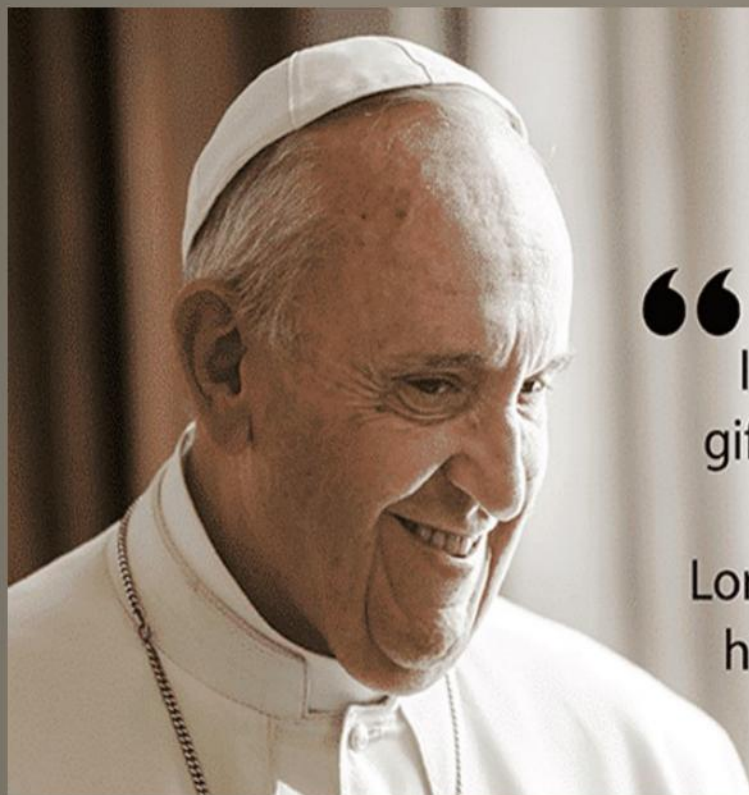
