Message from the Pastor

Mensaje del Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend we celebrate **Corpus Christi** – the **Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ**. When we receive Holy Communion we are receiving the **true body and blood, soul and divinity** of our Savior Jesus Christ, under the appearances of bread and wine.

Bread is the food staple of the entire world. It symbolizes physical sustenance. Thus, to have one's daily bread is tantamount to having food to nourish the body for the day. In today's First Reading, Moses reminds us that more than physical food, we need the Word of God, for "not by bread alone does one live, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of the Lord".

Jesus, the Word of God (see: John 1:1), is the Living Bread that has come down from heaven to nourish us unto everlasting life! And "unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you", Christ says to us. The principle at play here is simple. Christ is the Source of Life for "all things came to be through him, and without him nothing came to be. What came to be through him was life" (John 1:3-4). To receive Christ therefore is to receive the gift of everlasting life. And he assures us this truth when he says that "whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day".

In the Eucharist, Christ brings heaven to us, for heaven is a participation in the eternal life of God. The Eucharist is Christ, "the bread that came down from heaven". Believe!

Believe because Christ, the Word of God, says it is so. He shows us how at the Last Supper, when he broke and blessed the bread, declaring it to be his body, as well as the wine, which he blessed and gave us as his "blood of the covenant, which will be shed for the forgiveness of sins" (see: **Matthew 26:26-28**).

In the Eucharist, Christ gives us a *concrete* way to partake of his body and blood (see: today's Second Reading – **1 Corinthians 10:16-17**). Let us pray for the grace to always strive to receive Christ in the Holy Eucharist with reverence, in faith, and with a clear conscience, amen.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

Este fin de semana celebramos el Corpus Christi, la **Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo**. Cuando recibimos la Sagrada Comunión estamos recibiendo el **verdadero cuerpo y sangre, alma y divinidad** de nuestro Salvador Jesucristo, bajo las apariencias de pan y vino.

El pan es el alimento básico de todo el mundo. Simboliza el sustento físico. Así, tener el pan de cada día equivale a tener comida para nutrir el cuerpo durante el día. En la Primera Lectura de hoy, Moisés nos recuerda que más que el alimento físico, necesitamos la Palabra de Dios, porque "no sólo de pan se vive, sino de toda palabra que sale de la boca del Señor".

¡Jesús, la Palabra de Dios (ver: **Juan 1:1**), es el Pan Vivo que ha bajado del cielo para nutrirnos hasta la vida eterna! Y "si no coméis la carne del Hijo del hombre y bebéis su sangre, no tenéis vida en vosotros", nos dice Cristo. El principio en juego aquí es simple. Cristo es la Fuente de la Vida porque "todas las cosas llegaron a ser por medio de él, y sin él nada llegó a ser. Lo que vino a ser a través de él fue la **vida**" (**Juan 1:3-4**). Por lo tanto, recibir a Cristo es recibir el don de la vida eterna. Y nos asegura esta verdad cuando dice que "el que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre tiene vida eterna, y yo lo resucitaré en el último día".

En la Eucaristía, Cristo nos trae el cielo, porque el cielo es una participación en la vida eterna de Dios. La Eucaristía es Cristo, "el pan que descendió del cielo". ¡Creer!

Cree porque Cristo, la Palabra de Dios, así lo dice. Nos muestra cómo en la Última Cena, cuando partió y bendijo el pan, declarando que era su cuerpo, así como el vino, que bendijo y nos dio como su "sangre de la alianza, que será derramada por el perdón de los pecados" (ver: Mateo 26:26-28).

En la Eucaristía, Cristo nos da una forma concreta de participar de su cuerpo y sangre (ver: Segunda Lectura de hoy – **1 Corintios 10:16-17**). Oremos por la gracia de esforzarnos siempre por recibir a Cristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía con reverencia, en la fe y con la conciencia limpia, amén.

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!
