Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

As we celebrate Father's Day, we want to wish all fathers a happy celebration as well as offer them our love and gratitude. The place of a good and loving father in the life of any individual is indispensable. I am grateful for my daddy, Mr. Michael Ezuma, who has taught me important life lessons throughout my life. My dad reminds me of the strength, patience and wisdom of God, our Heavenly Father.

Interestingly, one of the enduring life's lessons my dad taught me occurred at a time of difficulty and challenges in my life. I was about thirteen years old and was in a Catholic boarding high school for boys, which is located in the south-western region of Nigeria. I hated that we were required to wake up at 5am in the morning, that I had to deal with bullies every now and then, that the food was not as good as what I was accustomed to at home, the list goes on. In desperation, I remember saying to my father then: "dad, if you love me, please take me away from this school". Note the tinge of manipulation in my request - of course my dad loves me! In any case, he did not fall for my manipulation but in love and with great wisdom said to me in response, "my son, give it one more year. And if you still feel this way by this time next year, I promise that I will grant your request".

I would end up graduating from the same school. The above exchange with my father engraved in me the lesson of cultivating the virtue of perseverance in the face of difficulties. God, our Heavenly Father desires the very best for all of us, his children. And so, he gently walks with us, providing us with loving discipline so that we can avoid sin and all that is destructive to life eternal in order that we might come to live with him for all eternity in his kingdom.

The following passage from the **Letter to the Hebrews** sums it up well: "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith. For the sake of the joy that lay before him he endured the cross, despising its shame, and has taken his seat at the right of the throne of God. Endure your trials as "discipline"; God treats you as sons. For what "son" is there whom his father does not discipline? At the time, all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it. (12:1-2, 7, 11)".

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

Mientras celebramos el Día del Padre, queremos desearles a todos los padres una feliz celebración y ofrecerles nuestro amor y gratitud. El lugar de un padre bueno y amoroso en la vida de cualquier individuo es indispensable. Estoy agradecido por mi papá, el Sr. Michael Ezuma, quien me ha enseñado importantes lecciones de vida a lo largo de mi vida. Mi papá me recuerda la fuerza, la paciencia y la sabiduría de Dios, nuestro Padre Celestial.

Curiosamente, una de las lecciones de vida perdurables que me enseñó mi padre ocurrió en un momento de dificultad y desafíos en mi vida. Tenía unos trece años y asistía a un internado católico para varones en la región sudoccidental de Nigeria. Odiaba que tuviéramos que levantarnos a las 5 a.m. de la mañana, que tenía que lidiar con matones de vez en cuando, que la comida no era tan buena como a la que estaba acostumbrado en casa, y la lista continúa. Desesperada, recuerdo haberle dicho a mi padre entonces: "papá, si me amas, por favor sácame de esta escuela". Tenga en cuenta el matiz de manipulación en mi pedido: ¡por supuesto que mi papá me ama! En todo caso, él no cayó en mis manipulaciones sino que enamorado y con mucha sabiduría me dijo en respuesta, "hijo mío, dale un año más. Y si todavía te sientes así el año que viene, que prometo concederé tu petición".

Terminaría graduándome de la misma escuela. El anterior intercambio con mi padre grabó en mí la lección de cultivar la virtud de la perseverancia ante las dificultades. Dios, nuestro Padre Celestial desea lo mejor para todos nosotros, sus hijos. Y así, camina suavemente con nosotros, brindándonos disciplina amorosa para que podamos evitar el pecado y todo lo que es destructivo para la vida eterna para que podamos vivir con él por toda la eternidad en su reino.

El siguiente pasaje de la Carta a los Hebreos lo resume bien: "Por tanto, ya que estamos rodeados de una nube tan grande de testigos, deshagámonos de toda carga y pecado que nos asedia, y perseveremos en correr la carrera que nos espera. delante de nosotros manteniendo los ojos fijos en Jesús, el líder y consumador de la fe. Por causa del gozo que le esperaba soportó la cruz, menospreciando la vergüenza, y se ha sentado a la derecha del trono de Dios. Soportad vuestras pruebas como "disciplina"; Dios los trata como hijos. Porque ¿qué "hijo" hay a quien su padre no disciplina? En su momento, toda disciplina parece no ser causa de alegría sino de dolor, pero luego da frutos apacibles de justicia a los que en ella son instruidos. (12:1-2, 7, 11)".

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!






