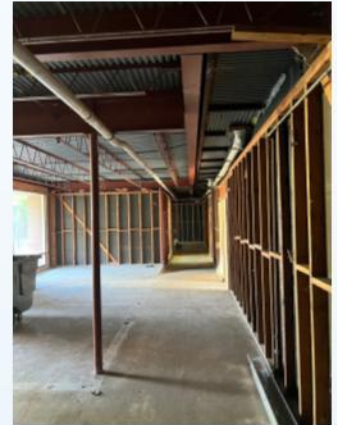

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Happy July 4th weekend! As we celebrate our independence, we call to mind these beautiful words of the Declaration of Independence: “We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed, by their Creator, with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness”.

That the above listed rights are designated as unalienable means that they are not contingent on one’s nationality, race, color, religion, etc; contrarily, they are God-given! As such, no one may be deprived of these rights. True justice demands therefore that all humans – and that includes the unborn – are accorded access to these foundational human rights.

God is the foundation of human dignity and it is only by adhering to God’s law that we can uphold the dignity of all. Why it is utopic to expect a perfect society in which everyone is treated fairly with equity and justice, we must endeavor to do our best to uphold the rights and wellbeing of all. Imagine how brighter our world would be if everyone sought to apply the Golden Rule in their dealings with one another!

As we seek to make the world a better place for all, let us remember that ultimately, “our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we also await a savior, the Lord Jesus Christ” (**Philippians 3:20**). This in no way is to suggest that as followers of Christ, we should be apathetic to the state of affairs in the world. Au contraire, Vatican II “exhorts Christians, as citizens of two cities, to strive to discharge their earthly duties conscientiously and in response to the Gospel spirit. They are mistaken who, knowing that we have here no abiding city but seek one which is to come, think that they may therefore shirk their earthly responsibilities. For they are forgetting that by the faith itself they are more obliged than ever to measure up to these duties, each according to his proper vocation” (**Gaudium et Spes, 43**).

Therefore, my brothers and sisters, guided by faith, let us work to make the world a better place, starting with our local communities, even as we keep our eyes focused on heaven.

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

¡Feliz fin de semana del 4 de julio! Mientras celebramos nuestra independencia, recordamos estas hermosas palabras de la Declaración de Independencia: “Sostenemos que estas verdades son evidentes por sí mismas, que todos los hombres son creados iguales, que su Creador los dotó de ciertos derechos inalienables, que entre ellas están la vida, la libertad y la búsqueda de la felicidad”.

Que los derechos enumerados anteriormente se designen como inalienables significa que no están supeditados a la nacionalidad, raza, color, religión, etc.; por el contrario, ¡son dados por Dios! Como tal, nadie puede ser privado de estos derechos. La verdadera justicia exige, por lo tanto, que todos los seres humanos, y eso incluye a los no nacidos, tengan acceso a estos derechos humanos fundamentales.

Dios es el fundamento de la dignidad humana y solo al adherirnos a la ley de Dios podemos defender la dignidad de todos. Por qué es utópico esperar una sociedad perfecta en la que todos sean tratados con equidad y justicia, debemos esforzarnos por hacer todo lo posible para defender los derechos y el bienestar de todos. ¡Imagínese cuán brillante sería nuestro mundo si todos trataran de aplicar la regla de oro en sus tratos con los demás!

Mientras buscamos hacer del mundo un lugar mejor para todos, recordemos que, en última instancia, “nuestra ciudadanía está en los cielos, y de allí también esperamos un salvador, el Señor Jesucristo” (**Filipenses 3:20**). Esto de ninguna manera sugiere que, como seguidores de Cristo, debamos ser apáticos ante el estado de las cosas en el mundo. Por el contrario, el Concilio Vaticano II “exhorta a los cristianos, como ciudadanos de dos ciudades, a esforzarse por cumplir con conciencia y en respuesta al espíritu evangélico sus deberes terrenales. Se equivocan los que, sabiendo que aquí no tenemos ciudad permanente, sino que buscamos la venidera, piensan que por eso pueden eludir sus responsabilidades terrenales. Porque olvidan que por la misma fe están más obligados que nunca a estar a la altura de estos deberes, cada uno según su propia vocación” (**Gaudium et spes, 43**).

Por lo tanto, mis hermanos y hermanas, guiados por la fe, trabajemos para hacer del mundo un lugar mejor, comenzando con nuestras comunidades locales, aunque mantengamos la mirada puesta en el cielo.

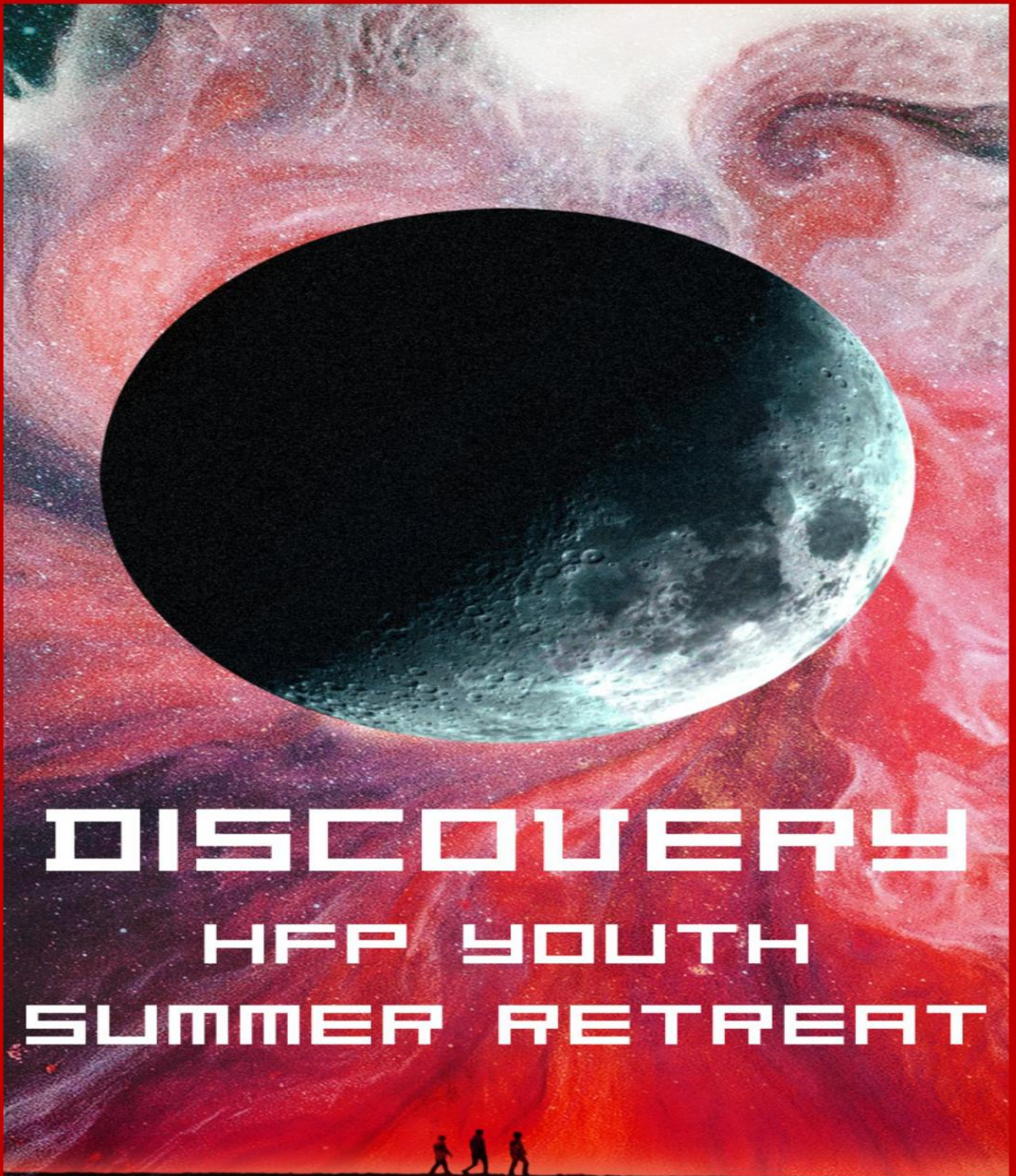

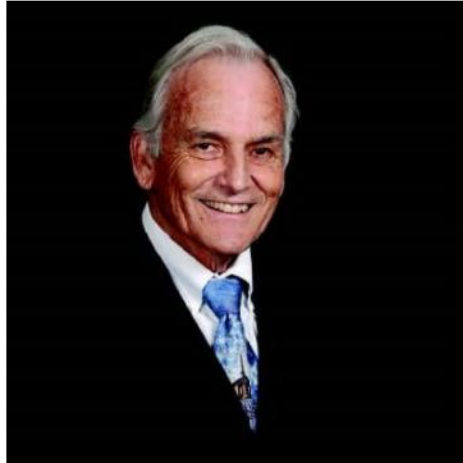
