Mensaje del Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

In our parish book club, we just recently finished the book He Leadeth Me by Fr. Walter Ciszek, who was a Jesuit priest who spent 23 years in a Soviet prison and labor camp simply because he was a priest and falsely convicted of being a "Vatican spy". In this book he reflects on his time in prison and shares the spiritual fruits that he gained from these years. The central theme of the book centers on knowing and doing the will of God in daily life. This is really the most important thing in all of our lives: to know the will of God and do it. Christ himself is clear throughout the Gospels that he came to do the will of his Father; and as that was Christ's mission, so is it ours. With this being the case, the question then becomes, how to know the will of God so that we may do it. In answer to this question, Ciszek writes, "[God's] will for us [is] the twenty-four hours of each day: the people, the places, the circumstances he [sets] before us in that time. Those [are] the things God [knows] [are] important to him and to us at that moment, and those [are] the things upon which he [wants] us to act" (Ciszek, 38). God's will for us are the situations and the circumstances that he places before us each day and he desires that we act upon these situations, whatever they may be, because, "perfection [consists] simply in learning to discover God's will in every situation and then in bending every effort to do what must be done" (Ciszek, 77). In life, wherever you may find yourself, strive to see the situations and circumstances of each day as God's will for you, and act upon them with faith and virtue always doing what is right, and not just what is easiest. Be faithful to the daily duties of your vocation, because this is what God has entrusted to you and fidelity in daily life, fidelity to the small things, leads to holiness. If you have never read this book, I would highly recommend reading it; it is a great read and will greatly benefit your spiritual life.

Amadísimos en Cristo:

En nuestro club de lectura de la parroquia, recientemente terminamos el libro Él me guía del P. Walter Ciszek, quien fue un sacerdote jesuita que pasó 23 años en una prisión soviética y un campo de trabajos forzados simplemente porque era sacerdote y falsamente condenado por ser un "espía del Vaticano". En este libro reflexiona sobre su tiempo en prisión y comparte los frutos espirituales que obtuvo de estos años. El tema central del libro se centra en conocer y hacer la voluntad de Dios en la vida diaria. Esto es realmente lo más importante en todas nuestras vidas: conocer la voluntad de Dios y hacerla. Cristo mismo es claro a lo largo de los Evangelios que vino a hacer la voluntad de su Padre; y como esa fue la misión de Cristo, así es la nuestra. Siendo este el caso, la pregunta entonces se convierte en cómo conocer la voluntad de Dios para que podamos hacerla. En respuesta a esta pregunta, Ciszek escribe: "La voluntad [de Dios] para nosotros [son] las veinticuatro horas de cada día: la gente, los lugares, las circunstancias que él [pone] delante de nosotros en ese tiempo. Esas [son] las cosas que Dios [sabe] [son] importantes para él y para nosotros en ese momento, y esas [son] las cosas sobre las que [quiere] que actuemos" (Ciszek, 38). La voluntad de Dios para nosotros son las situaciones y las circunstancias que nos pone delante cada día y desea que actuemos sobre estas situaciones, sean las que sean, porque "la perfección [consiste] simplemente en aprender a descubrir la voluntad de Dios en cada situación y luego en hacer todo lo posible para hacer lo que debe hacerse" (Ciszek, 77). En la vida, donde guiera gue te encuentres, esfuérzate por ver las situaciones y circunstancias de cada día como la voluntad de Dios para ti, y actúa sobre ellas con fe y virtud haciendo siempre lo correcto, y no solo lo más fácil. Sed fieles a los deberes cotidianos de vuestra vocación, porque esto es lo que Dios os ha confiado y la fidelidad en la vida cotidiana, la fidelidad a las cosas pequeñas, conduce a la santidad. Si nunca ha leído este libro, le recomiendo mucho que lo lea; es una gran lectura y beneficiará grandemente su vida espiritual.

St. Mary of the Miraculous Medal Catholic Community is celebrating a special Mass for prayers towards the sainthood of Blessed Stanley Rother. This will be held on Thursday, July 27, 2023, 6:00 p.m. at the parish which is located at 1604 - 9th Avenue N, Texas City, TX 77590 by our pastor Father Clint.

"Father Stanley Francis Rother was born March 27, 1935, in Okarche, Oklahoma. He was a farm boy. Ordained a priest for the Diocese of Oklahoma City and Tulsa in 1963, he served in the diocese's Guatemala mission for fourteen years. He served the native Tzutuhil tribe, who are decedents of the Mayans. In order to serve his people, Fr. Rother learned both Spanish and the Tzutuhil language. Surrounded by extreme poverty, Fr. Rother ministered to his parishioners in their homes, eating with them, visiting the sick, aiding with medical problems and helping farm. While he served in Guatemala, a civil war raged between the militarist government forces and the guerillas. During this, conflict hundreds of thousands of Catholics were killed due to the Church's insistence on helping people, including many people in the Quiche area where we have a sister parish in Santa Cruz del Quiche and where Sending Out Servants (SOS) does much of their missionary work. Eventually, Fr. Rother was targeted. For his safety, Fr. Rother returned to Oklahoma. Determined to give his life completely to his people, he stated that "the shepherd cannot run." Returning to Santiago Atitlan, he continued to minister to his people. Within days of his return, three men entered the rectory and executed Fr. Rother. Seeking justice in the midst of a protracted civil war, Fr. Rother fought courageously for the well-being of his people.

When he becomes a saint, he will be the first named martyr and priest from the United States. Please come and pray for his sainthood."

Faith Formation



Our Sacramental preparation program is paired with faith formation classes at Holy Family Catholic School. Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion can be started in second grade; third through eight graders who have not yet received these sacraments may also register. Parents are required to attend introductory meeting known as "Parent Orientation"

The program will start with First Reconciliation and then move into preparation for first Communion. In the Reconciliation preparation, there are 3 classes and it ends with a Reconciliation Retreat with first penance. In the Eucharist preparation, there are also 3 classes and it ends with a Retreat followed by the First Eucharist celebration. Please note that the classes are not Optional.

Parents Role

The Importance of Parents role in helping to prepare their children in this important Sacrament cannot be over emphasized. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, "Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children" {CCC 2223} it also states that "the role of parents in education is of such importance that it is almost impossible to provide an adequate substitute. The right and the duty of parents to educate their children are primordial and inalienable" {CCC 2221} In Holy Family Parish we support parents in their essential role in passing on the faith to their children that is why we also have parent sessions.

Faith Formation



Nuestro programa de preparación sacramental se combina con clases de formación en la fe en la Escuela Católica Sagrada Familia. Según el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, "Los padres tienen la primera responsabilidad de la educación de sus hijos" {CIC 2223} también afirma que "el papel de los padres en la educación es de tal importancia que es casi imposible proporcionar un sustituto adecuado. El derecho y el deber de los padres de educar a sus hijos son primordiales e inalienables" {CIC 2221}

En la Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia apoyamos a los padres en su papel esencial en la transmisión de la fe a sus hijos, por eso también tenemos sesiones para padres.


