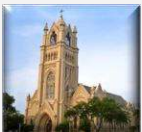

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Seven months ago – precisely on the weekend of February 4/5, parishes through-out the archdiocese launched the **annual Diocesan Services Fund (DSF)** campaign. Through this annual fundraiser, vital ministries that provide social, pastoral and educational services throughout the archdiocese are sustained. When you give to DSF, you are supporting the formation of our future priests; serving those in need; helping to form the next generation of Catholics through children, youth and adult faith formation programs in parishes throughout the archdiocese; and providing a solid Catholic educational foundation to all the students in our Catholic schools.

At the start of the DSF campaign every year, each parish is assessed a goal, based on the parish size and a calculation of the average annual collection of the parish. Our goal this year is **\$92,000** (ninety-two thousand dollars). Since resuming here as your pastor, I have always been amazed at your great generosity. Not only have we always made goal, we usually supersede it!

The good news is that 75% of every dollar we raise over our allotted goal will be returned directly to our parish. Right now we have raised just about **\$80,000** (eighty thousand dollars). We know that many have already made their contributions this year; but there are still a lot more who are yet to do so. Please help us reach out parish goal.

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

Hace siete meses, precisamente el fin de semana del 4 y 5 de febrero, las parroquias de toda la arquidiócesis lanzaron la campaña **anual del Fondo de Servicios Diocesanos (DSF)**. A través de esta recaudación de fondos anual, se sostienen ministerios vitales que brindan servicios sociales, pastorales y educativos en toda la arquidiócesis. Cuando donas a DSF, estás apoyando la formación de nuestros futuros sacerdotes; servir a los necesitados; ayudar a formar la próxima generación de católicos a través de programas de formación en la fe para niños, jóvenes y adultos en parroquias de toda la arquidiócesis; y proporcionar una base educativa católica sólida a todos los estudiantes de nuestras escuelas católicas.

Al comienzo de la campaña DSF cada año, a cada parroquia se le asigna una meta, basada en el tamaño de la parroquia y un cálculo de la recaudación anual promedio de la parroquia. Nuestra meta este año es **\$92,000** (noventa y dos mil dólares). Desde que regresé aquí como su pastor, siempre me ha sorprendido su gran generosidad. ¡No sólo siempre hemos marcado el gol, sino que normalmente lo superamos!

La buena noticia es que el 75% de cada dólar que recaudemos por encima de nuestra meta asignada será devuelto directamente a nuestra parroquia. En este momento hemos recaudado alrededor de **\$80,000** (ochenta mil dólares). Sabemos que muchos ya han hecho sus aportes este año; pero todavía hay muchos más que aún no lo han hecho. 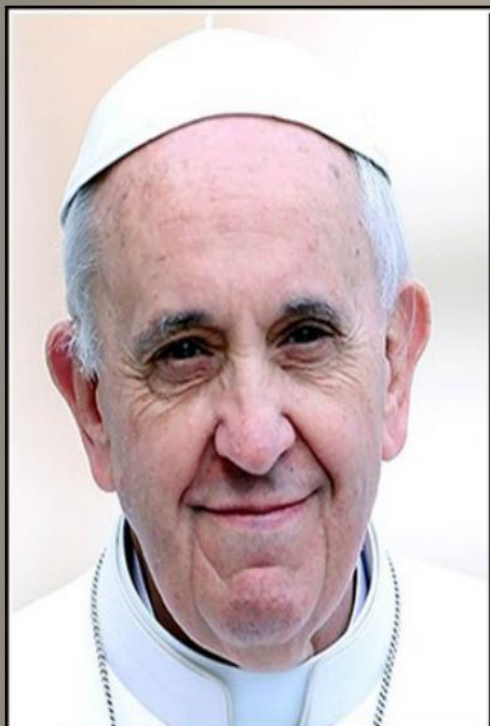

Eucharistic Miracles: What is a Eucharistic Miracle?

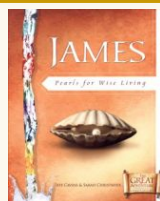
“Jesus is my great friend and the Eucharist, my highway to Heaven”-

Throughout history, our Lord has shown us that He is really present as the Blessed Sacrament, the Most Holy Eucharist. Many Eucharistic miracles have occurred during times of weakened Faith. For instance, many Eucharistic miracles have taken place as a result of someone doubting the Real Presence. Most miracles involve incidences in which the Host has “turned into human flesh and blood”.

Of course, we, as Catholics, believe that the consecrated Host is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord, under the appearances of bread and wine. Therefore, Jesus, through these miracles, merely manifests His Presence in a more tangible way.

Starting next week till the end of the year of the Eucharistic Revival in June 2024, we will have in the bulletin, weekly stories of these miracles of the Eucharist, approved by the Vatican, which have occurred over the centuries.

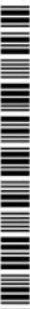
