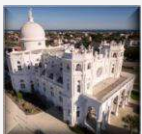

Holy Family Parish is unique in that we have 6 places of worship, 3 priests and over 2000 registered families. The Parish Office is located at the St. Patrick school building, clergy offices are made wherever there is space in that same building, and our one space known as the Parish Life Center has no air conditioning.

Several years ago, a survey was given to all parishioners, asking what you see for the future of HFP and what you envision as the most immediate concern. The #1 need that you, the parishioners agreed upon, is a space large enough to bring all of us together as one, for parish ministry, fellowship, and office spaces.

How very fortunate that the needed space is available on the grounds of HF Catholic School, 2601 Ursuline. Space that was once occupied by the Ursuline Nuns and space that has been unused for years. Architects got busy and converted the unused space into a new and spacious Parish Life Center with offices for all clergy and staff members, adequate parking and so much more.

Our One Faith One Family Campaign is to raise \$5.5 million dollars for this renovation. There is another committee at work made up of architects and engineers, all parishioners, who are looking for common sense ways to reduce cost. Had this space not been available, the cost for a project like this would have been much higher.

Please help us meet our goal! Holy Family Parish, Fr. Jude, Fr. Jacob, Fr. Stephen, all of our sisters, deacons, all staff members are here for each and every one of us.

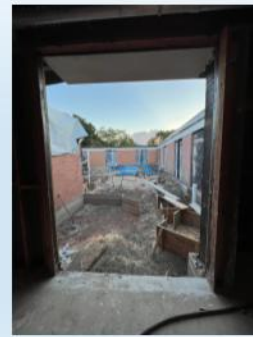
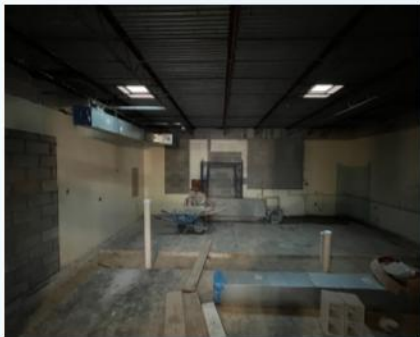

Also, on **Friday, October 20th**, our students at Holy Family School will be organizing a **Rosary Rally** at **Kempner Park**, starting at 10AM.

We hope you will mark these events on your calendar and join us as we sing the praises of God for the gift of the Blessed Virgin Mother Mary, our mother, who helps us on our pilgrimage to heaven. The **40 Day Perpetual Eucharistic** adoration and exposition will take place in the chapel of our Lady of Guadalupe. We will repeat this again during the season of Lent next year (from **February 6 to March 19th, 2024**). 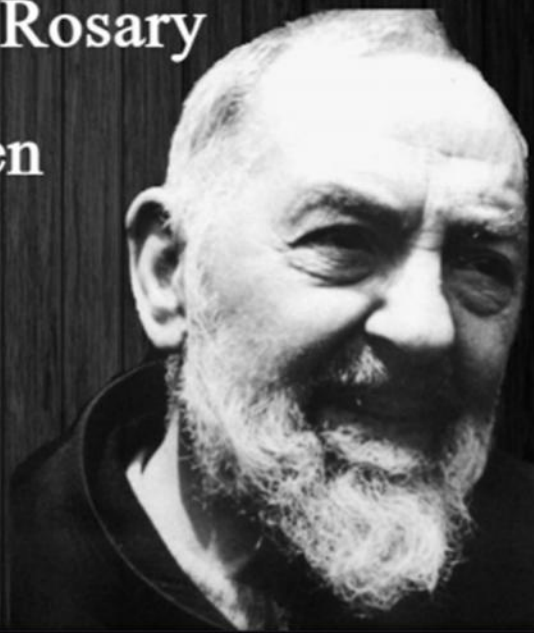

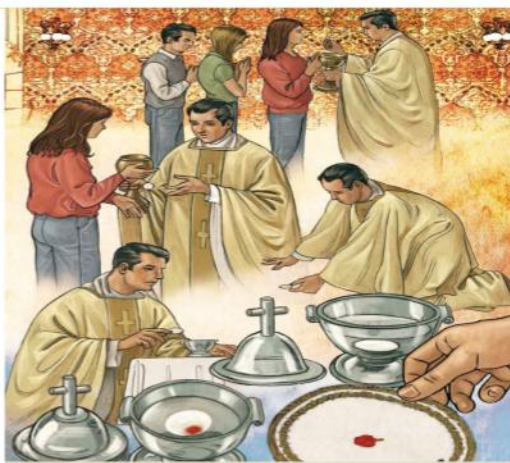

Eucharistic Miracle of LEGNICA

POLAND, 2013

In St. Hyacinth's church in Legnica, during Holy Mass, on December 25, 2013, a Host accidentally fell on the ground, during the distribution of Communion. It was immediately placed in a container with water and closed in the tabernacle as required by code of Canon Law. A few days later, a red spot appeared on Its surface. The Bishop of Legnica at the time, Stefan Cichy, decided to establish a commission for a scientific analysis. The results were surprising, and confirmed that It had similarities to “human heart muscle with alterations that often appear during the agony”.



On December 25, 2013, the priest who distributed Communion accidentally dropped a Host from a ciborium. The priest picked it up and put it in a container with water and placed it in the tabernacle.



Doctor and cardiologist Professor Barbara Engel, who was one of the scientists involved in the scientific analysis, said during the press conference: “The material was analyzed using UV rays with an orange filter and the results were univocal. We have identified myocardial fibres, typical of myocardial tissue with alterations that often appear during the agony.”

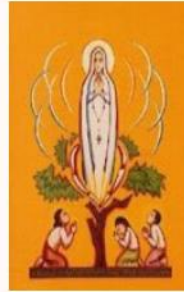

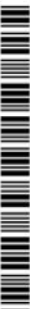
