Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Do you believe that Jesus Christ is truly present in the Holy Eucharist? If you do, then come and spend some time with him, especially during our upcoming 40-Day Eucharistic Exposition and Adoration. This opportunity of perpetual adoration of Christ who is truly present in the Holy Eucharist is part of our celebration, as members of Holy Family Parish, in the ongoing national Eucharistic Revival.

On page 10 of this bulletin, you will find a listing of all the activities that will be taking place in our parish to help us grow in love, devotion and understanding of the Holy Eucharist. The goal of the national Eucharistic Revival is to help us grow in appreciation of the inestimable gift we have in the Holy Eucharist – that is, the gift of Christ himself.

In our Second Reading today, Saint Paul exhorts us to "Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." When we spend time before the Blessed Sacrament, whether in prayerful silence or by simply being there, we come before Jesus who is our true peace.

We have an overwhelming amount of testimonies from the saints about the amazing blessings that come to those who make it a habit to spend time with Jesus who is present in the Holy Eucharist. Saint (Padre) Pio encourages us to "always remain close to the Catholic Church, because it alone can give you true peace, since it alone possesses Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, the true Prince of Peace". And Mother Theresa reminds us that "Jesus has made Himself the Bread of Life to give us life. Night and day, He is there. If you really want to grow in love, come back to the Eucharist, come back to that Adoration".

So, do you believe that Jesus Christ is truly present in the Holy Eucharist? Even if your response is not firm, come as you are. Come with your family, your friends, by yourself, as a group.... Just come; Christ waits for you lovingly.

The most recent practical link to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the devotional icon of the Lord's Merciful love came from the Polish nun Saint Faustina Kowalska. Jesus appeared to her on February 22, 1931, with His right hand bestowing blessings and His left hand pointing towards His Sacred Heart, which emitted two rays: one pale; the other a bright red. These rays represent the Water and Blood that came out of Jesus' pierced side while on the Cross. This symbolizes the purifying virtues of Baptism and Confession and the regenerative virtue of the Holy Eucharist.








