## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend, the Universal Church celebrates *World Mission Sunday*. The Gospel of Matthew concludes with Christ's Great Command to us, his disciples, to "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you!" (Matthew 28:19-20).

World Mission Sunday provides all believers a unique opportunity to support the missionary efforts of the Church. For this year's theme, Pope Francis chose the phrase – Hearts on fire, feet on the move. This year's theme invites us to think of the disciples who encountered Jesus on their way to Emmaus and how their encounter with Christ set their hearts on fire: "Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?", they said (see **Luke 24:13-35).** 

We pray that through our actions, we may be earnest, like the disciples on their way to Emmaus, in proclaiming the good news of the Gospel to all. When we give to the World Mission Sunday collection, we are supporting the Church in her efforts to "make disciples of all nations".

Cardinal DiNardo, in his letter to the priests, regarding this year's World Mission Sunday, shared with us the scope of the invaluable support that is provided by the faithful in the United States. "The World Mission Sunday collection in the United States supports CNEWA (Catholic Near East Welfare Association) aiding the Oriental Churches in need with 9% of the contributions. It also supports the Pontifical Council on Latin America that directs 5% of the gifts to aid the poorest jurisdictions in South America and the Caribbean. The balance (86%) supports the Church in those dioceses in Africa and Asia, which are designated as mission territories. Last year, the Society for the Propagation of the Faith in the United States sent over \$23 million to the bishops, priests, religious brothers and sisters, and lay missionaries who help spread the Gospel in these territories".

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

## Mensaje del Pastor

Este fin de semana, la Iglesia Universal celebra el *Domingo Mundial de las Misiones*. El Evangelio de Mateo concluye con el gran mandato de Cristo a nosotros, sus discípulos, de "Id, pues, y haced discípulos a todas las naciones, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo, enseñándoles ¡Observad todo lo que os he mandado! (Mateo 28:19-20).

El Domingo Mundial de las Misiones brinda a todos los creyentes una oportunidad única de apoyar los esfuerzos misioneros de la Iglesia. Para el tema de este año, el Papa Francisco eligió la frase: Corazones encendidos, pies en camino. El tema de este año nos invita a pensar en los discípulos que encontraron a Jesús en su camino a Emaús y cómo su encuentro con Cristo encendió sus corazones: "¿No ardía nuestro corazón dentro de nosotros, mientras él nos hablaba en el camino y nos abría las Escrituras? ¿A nosotros?", dijeron (ver Lucas 24:13-35).

Oramos para que, a través de nuestras acciones, seamos sinceros, como los discípulos en camino a Emaús, en proclamar la buena nueva del Evangelio a todos. Cuando donamos para la colecta del Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, estamos apoyando a la Iglesia en sus esfuerzos por "hacer discípulos de todas las naciones".

El Cardenal DiNardo, en su carta a los sacerdotes, sobre el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones de este año, compartió con nosotros el alcance del invaluable apoyo que brindan los fieles en los Estados Unidos. "La colecta del Domingo Mundial de las Misiones en Estados Unidos apoya a la CNEWA (Asociación Católica de Bienestar del Cercano Oriente) que ayuda a las Iglesias Orientales necesitadas con el 9% de las contribuciones. También apoya al Consejo Pontificio para América Latina que destina el 5% de las donaciones a ayudar a las jurisdicciones más pobres de América del Sur y el Caribe. El resto (86%) apoya a la Iglesia en aquellas diócesis de África y Asia, que están designadas como territorios de misión. El año pasado, la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe en los Estados Unidos envió más de 23 millones de dólares a los obispos, sacerdotes, hermanos y hermanas religiosos y misioneros laicos que ayudan a difundir el Evangelio en estos territorios".

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!


### RCIA AND ADULT CONTINUING FAITH FORMATION

Sunday, October 12, 2008 a priest distributing Communion dropped a consecrated Host. He picked it up and placed it in a vessel filled with water and put it in the tabernacle. Three years later after not disintegrating, the sample of the Host was analyzed by 2 professionals separately. They issued a declaration stating: the sample sent for evaluation looks like myocardial (heart) tissue of a living person who is nearing death. The structure of the heart muscle fibers is deeply intertwined with that of the bread, in a way impossible to achieve with human means.




