## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

As the month of October comes to a close, we cannot help but think of the coming festivities, especially Thanksgiving and Christmas. There is another important celebration with Christian origins that is worth mentioning – Halloween! Yes, that one. Do you know that the word Halloween is a contraction of “All Hallows’ Eve”?

All Hallows’ Eve is the day before All Saints Day (or, All Hallows Day). In its origin therefore, All Hallows Eve (a.k.a., Halloween Day) is meant to be a day of preparation for the celebration of the feast of All Saints Day. How our popular culture has hijacked this holy day! It is up to us to reclaim the beauty of this holiday by emphasizing its roots in our belief in the resurrection and our communion with the saints. One way to do this and *hallow* (i.e., ‘make holy’) Halloween is to teach our children about the heroic virtues of the saints as well as encourage them to imitate their exemplary Christian lives.

Providentially, we will be starting a **40 Day Perpetual Eucharistic Exposition and Adoration** on the day of Halloween – Tuesday, October 31st. How amazing it would be if families took some time on Halloween’s day to stop by the chapel and spend some time with Jesus Christ who is truly present in the Eucharist! Who knows, this might just be the start of a new family tradition for your children – a great way to teach them about the blessings of living our lives in imitation of the saints.

November 1 – All Saints Day, is a holy day of obligation. On All Souls Day – November 2<sup>nd</sup>, we remember and pray for all the dead, especially our loved ones. As is our custom, we have placed the **Book of the Names of the Dead** in the entryway at all the churches. We encourage you to take a moment to write down the names of your deceased loved ones. We will be praying for them and all the dead on All Souls Day and throughout the month of November.

The mass schedule for All Saints and All Souls day are published on page 6 of this bulletin. Also included in this bulletin is a **Novena for the Holy Souls in Purgatory** both in English and in Spanish on page 12. Let us pray that God may grant His eternal rest to all the faithful departed, Amen!

## Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

A medida que el mes de octubre llega a su fin, no podemos evitar pensar en las próximas festividades, especialmente Acción de Gracias y Navidad. Hay otra celebración importante de origen cristiano que vale la pena mencionar: ¡Halloween! Sí, ese. ¿Sabías que la palabra Halloween es una contracción de “All Hallows’ Eve”?

La víspera de Todos los Santos es el día anterior al Día de Todos los Santos (o Día de Todos los Santos). Por lo tanto, en su origen, All Hallows Eve (también conocido como Día de Halloween) pretende ser un día de preparación para la celebración de la fiesta del Día de Todos los Santos. ¡Cómo nuestra cultura popular se ha apropiado de este día santo! Depende de nosotros recuperar la belleza de esta festividad enfatizando sus raíces en nuestra creencia en la resurrección y nuestra comunión con los santos. Una forma de hacer esto y santificar (es decir, “santificar”) Halloween es enseñar a nuestros hijos acerca de las virtudes heroicas de los santos y animarlos a imitar sus vidas cristianas ejemplares.

Providencialmente, comenzaremos una **Exposición Eucarística Perpetua y Adoración de 40 días** el día de Halloween, el martes 31 de octubre. ¡Qué maravilloso sería si las familias se tomaran un tiempo el día de Halloween para pasar por la capilla y pasar un tiempo con Jesucristo, quien está verdaderamente presente en la Eucaristía! Quién sabe, esto podría ser sólo el comienzo de una nueva tradición familiar para sus hijos: una excelente manera de enseñarles acerca de las bendiciones de vivir nuestras vidas imitando a los santos.

1 de noviembre: Día de Todos los Santos, es un día santo de obligación. En el Día de los Difuntos, 2 de noviembre, recordamos y oramos por todos los muertos, especialmente por nuestros seres queridos. Como es nuestra costumbre, hemos colocado el **Libro de los Nombres de los Difuntos** en la entrada de todas las iglesias. Le recomendamos que se tome un momento para escribir los nombres de sus seres queridos fallecidos. Estaremos orando por ellos y por todos los muertos el Día de Todos los Difuntos y durante todo el mes de noviembre.

El horario de misas del día de Todos los Santos y de Todos los Difuntos se publica en la página 6 de este boletín. También se incluye en este boletín una **Novena por las Santas Almas del Purgatorio** tanto en inglés como en español en la página 12. Oremos para que Dios conceda Su eterno descanso a todos los fieles difuntos, ¡Amén!

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**

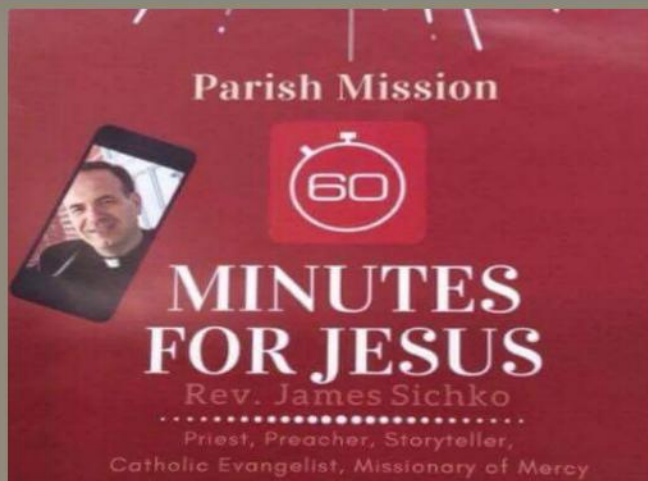
