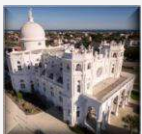

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Death comes to all! It is actually a healthy thing to occasionally contemplate the subject of death as it helps us to reflect on what life is truly about. Saint Paul, in today's Second Reading reminds us why as Christians, we should not be afraid of death. "We do not want you to be unaware, brothers and sisters, about those who have fallen asleep, so that you may not grieve like the rest, who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose, so too will God, through Jesus, bring with him those who have fallen asleep."

Hope! Christ has conquered death and has won for us the gift of everlasting life! It is therefore through faith in God and hope in the gift of resurrection that we can overcome the fear that death evokes. This hope fills us with wisdom, which guides us aright in life. More than an ideal, this wisdom becomes a way of life for those who trust in Christ. It invites us to embrace a life of joyful vigilance for the Lord always. In other words, rather than living at a frenetic and frantic pace, we approach life with confidence, striving always to make our choices in accordance with God's will.

This is demonstrated by the wise virgins spoken of in today's Gospel. In contrast to those who were reckoned as acting foolishly, the action of the wise virgins is a clarion call to all for the need to always keep the end goal forefront. Death is inevitable but it is but a passageway to eternity. Our eternal destiny will be shaped by the quality of life we live today and the decisions we take, as demonstrated clearly in the parable of the ten virgins.

So, what comes to your mind when you think of death? Certainly, our response to this question would vary but the Christian vision calls us to hope. This is exactly what St. Therese of Lisieux invites us to in her remarks about death: "It is not Death that will come to fetch me, it is the good God. Death is no phantom, no horrible specter, as presented in pictures. In the catechism it is stated that death is the separation of soul and body, that is all! Well, I am not afraid of a separation which will unite me to the good God forever."

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

¡La muerte llega a todos! En realidad, es saludable contemplar ocasionalmente el tema de la muerte, ya que nos ayuda a reflexionar sobre de qué se trata realmente la vida. San Pablo, en la Segunda Lectura de hoy, nos recuerda por qué, como cristianos, no debemos tener miedo a la muerte. "No queremos, hermanos, que ignoréis a los que han dormido, para que no os entristezcáis como los demás, que no tienen esperanza. Porque si creemos que Jesús murió y resucitó, así también Dios, por medio de Jesús, traerá consigo a los que durmieron".

¡Esperanza! ¡Cristo ha vencido la muerte y ha ganado para nosotros el don de la vida eterna! Por tanto, es a través de la fe en Dios y la esperanza en el don de la resurrección que podemos superar el miedo que evoca la muerte. Esta esperanza nos llena de sabiduría, que nos guía correctamente en la vida. Más que un ideal, esta sabiduría se convierte en una forma de vida para quienes confían en Cristo. Nos invita a abrazar siempre una vida de vigilancia gozosa por el Señor. En otras palabras, en lugar de vivir a un ritmo frenético y frenético, abordamos la vida con confianza, esforzándonos siempre por tomar nuestras decisiones de acuerdo con la voluntad de Dios.

Esto lo demuestran las vírgenes prudentes de las que habla el Evangelio de hoy. A diferencia de aquellos a quienes se consideraba que actuaban tontamente, la acción de las vírgenes prudentes es un llamado de atención a todos sobre la necesidad de mantener siempre el objetivo final en primer plano. La muerte es inevitable pero no es más que un pasadizo hacia la eternidad. Nuestro destino eterno estará determinado por la calidad de vida que vivamos hoy y las decisiones que tomemos, como lo demuestra claramente la parábola de las diez vírgenes.

Entonces, ¿qué te viene a la mente cuando piensas en la muerte? Ciertamente, nuestra respuesta a esta pregunta variará pero la visión cristiana nos llama a la esperanza. Esto es exactamente a lo que nos invita Santa Teresa de Lisieux en sus palabras sobre la muerte: "No es la muerte la que vendrá a buscarme, es el buen Dios. La muerte no es un fantasma, un espectro horrible, como se presenta en las imágenes. En el catecismo se afirma que la muerte es la separación del alma y el cuerpo, ¡eso es todo! Bueno, no tengo miedo de una separación que me unirá al buen Dios para siempre".

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**

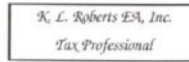

9 DAY NOVENA FOR THE POOR SOULS IN PURGATORY

Prayer to Jesus Christ for the Holy Souls (Author: St. Alphonsus Liguori)

(May be said in common or individually, anytime or as a novena, especially for All Souls Day. Being a novena (9 days of prayer), this prayer can be invoked at any time of the year. Ideally, it would be best to commence the novena on October 25th. This will allow the novena to coincide with the All Souls Feast Day on November 2nd .)

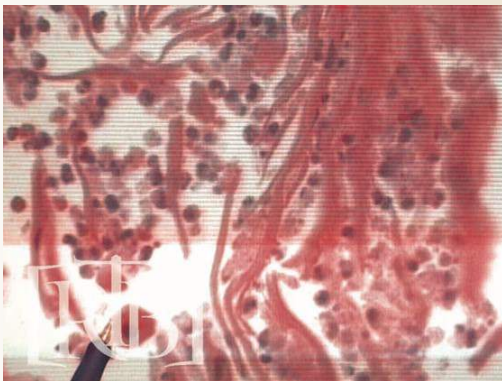
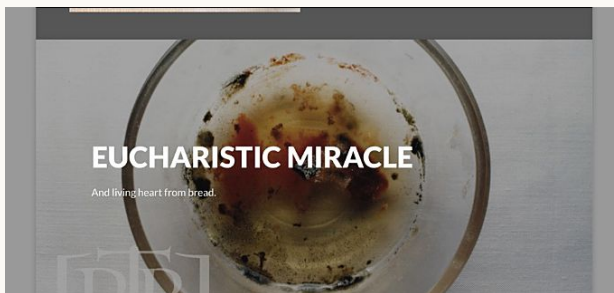

Scientific investigation of the Eucharistic Miracle of Buenos Aires, the facts, – the evidence and the findings

As a lawyer and a documentary filmmaker, I, Ron Tesoriero, was delighted to have been asked to assist in the investigation of the modern day case of the claimed Eucharistic Miracle of Buenos Aires. I had now the chance to personally probe answers to the many questions that I had about Eucharistic Miracles.

The Eucharistic Miracle of Buenos Aires happened in 1996 when a communion host appeared to have mysteriously transformed into flesh and blood.

With just Mike Willesee and myself in the room and a rolling camera, we were to hear and record Dr Zugibe's most astounding comments, which have now been reverberated throughout the world:

“this is heart muscle from the left ventricle wall of the heart not too far from a valvular area”. He went on to say that it was part of the muscle of the heart muscle that gives the heart its beat and the body its life.

From the presence of the white blood cells and the condition of the fibres of the heart tissue he was able to say that the person from whom this tissue had come was alive at the moment the sample was taken and that that person had suffered severe heart injury, a compromising of the blood supply to the heart, a matter of a few days before hand. He said that he had seen heart injury like that in cases where a person had been severely beaten around the chest.

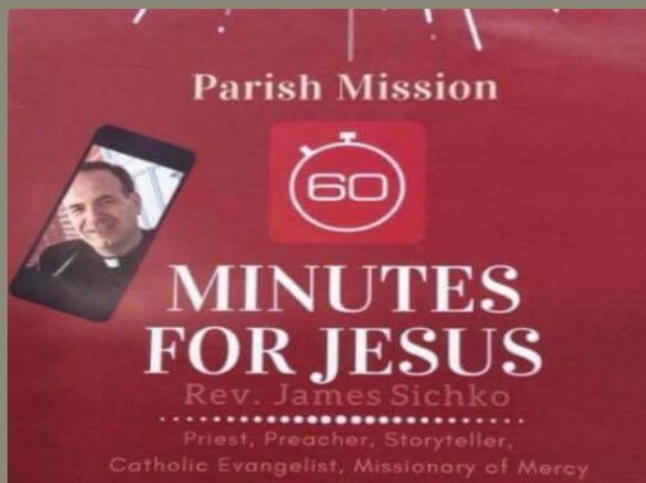
