Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the King of the Universe. Jesus, our King, is our eternal shepherd. As shepherd he leads us to his eternal kingdom where only goodness and kindness will follow us all the days of our life as we dwell in the house of the Lord.

Christ tells us very clearly what he expects of us in return if we truly want to live with him in his kingdom forever - that we be charitable! In the parable of the Last Judgment, Jesus uses charity that is, love in action – as the single criterion for judgment. As we celebrate Christ as the universal king, let us live in love today in preparation for our participation in his eternal kingdom tomorrow.



Eucharistic Miracle of San Mauro La Bruca, Italy 1969



At San Mauro la Bruca thieves broke into the parish church and stole several sacred objects – one was the ciborium that contained consecrated Hosts. The thieves threw the Hosts aside; the next morning a child discovered a small pile of Hosts at the corner of the path and immediately gave them to the pastor.

It was only in 1994, after 25 years of detailed analysis, the bishop officially recognized the miraculous preservation of the Hosts and approved their veneration. From the analysis carried out by scientists and chemists, we now know that normally, unleavened flour is heavily damaged after just 6 months, and at a maximum of a few years, is reduced to pulp and then, to dust. The Hosts are preserved to this day.
