



Message from the Pastor

Mensaje del Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This week, our **Dialogues with the Saints** series, is from a commentary by **Eusebius of Caesarea** on the section of the Prophet Isaiah we read in today's First Reading –

"The voice of one crying in the wilderness: Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight the paths of our God. The prophecy makes clear that it is to be fulfilled, not in Jerusalem but in the wilderness: it is there that the glory of the Lord is to appear, and God's salvation is to be made known to all mankind.

It was in the wilderness that God's saving presence was proclaimed by John the Baptist, and there that God's salvation was seen. The words of this prophecy were fulfilled when Christ and his glory were made manifest to all: after his baptism the heavens opened, and the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove rested on him, and the Father's voice was heard, bearing witness to the Son: *This is my beloved Son, listen to him.*

The prophecy meant that God was to come to a deserted place, inaccessible from the beginning. None of the pagans had any knowledge of God, since his holy servants and prophets were kept from approaching them. The voice commands that a way be prepared for the Word of God: the rough and trackless ground is to be made level, so that our God may find a highway when he comes. *Prepare the way of the Lord*: **the way is the preaching of the Gospel**, the new message of consolation, ready to bring to all mankind the knowledge of God's saving power.

Climb on a high mountain, bearer of good news to Zion. Lift up your voice in strength, bearer of good news to Jerusalem. These words harmonize very well with the meaning of what has gone before. They refer opportunely to the evangelists and proclaim the coming of God to men, after speaking of the voice crying in the wilderness. Mention of the evangelists suitably follows the prophecy on John the Baptist....

Who is the bearer of the good news but the company of the evangelists? What does it mean to bear the good news but to preach to all nations, but first of all to the cities of Judah, the coming of Christ on earth?"

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Esta semana, nuestra serie Diálogos con los Santos proviene de un comentario de Eusebio de Cesárea sobre la sección del profeta Isaías que leímos en la Primera Lectura de hoy -

"Una voz grita en el desierto: «Preparad un camino al Señor, allanad una calzada para nuestro Dios.» EL profeta declara abiertamente que su vaticinio no ha de realizarse en Jerusalén, sino en el desierto; a saber, que se manifestará la gloria del Señor, y la salvación de Dios llegará a conocimiento de todos los hombres.

Y todo esto, de acuerdo con la historia y a la letra, se cumplió precisamente cuando Juan Bautista predicó el advenimiento salvador de Dios en el desierto del Jordán, donde la salvación de Dios se dejó ver. Pues Cristo y su gloria se pusieron de manifiesto para todos cuando, una vez bautizado, se abrieron los cielos y el Espíritu Santo descendió en forma de paloma y se posó sobre él, mientras se oía la voz del Padre que daba testimonio de su Hijo: Éste es mi Hijo, el amado; escuchadlo.

Todo esto se decía porque Dios había de presentarse en el desierto, impracticable e inaccesible desde siempre. Se trataba, en efecto, de todas las gentes privadas del conocimiento de Dios, con las que no pudieron entrar en contacto los justos de Dios y los profetas. Por este motivo, aquella voz manda preparar un camino para la Palabra de Dios, así como allanar sus obstáculos y asperezas, para que cuando venga nuestro Dios pueda caminar sin dificultad. Preparad un camino al Señor: **se trata de la predicación evangélica** y de la nueva consolación, con el deseo de que la salvación de Dios llegue a conocimiento de todos los hombres.

Súbete a un monte elevado, heraldo de Sión; alza fuerte la voz, heraldo de Jerusalén. Estas expresiones de los antiguos profetas encajan muy bien y se refieren con oportunidad a los evangelistas: ellas anuncian el advenimiento de Dios a los hombres, después de haberse hablado de la voz que grita en el desierto. Pues a la profecía de Juan Bautista sigue coherentemente la mención de los evangelistas....

¿Y quién es el que evangeliza sino el coro apostólico? ¿Y qué es evangelizar? Predicar a todos los hombres, y en primer lugar a las ciudades de Judá, que Cristo ha venido a la tierra."

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!




RCIA AND ADULT CONTINUING FAITH FORMATION

EUCHARISTIC MIRACLE - SILLA, SPAIN 1907

Feast of the Annunciation 1907


On March 25, 1907, Father Fernando Gomez was preparing for the Feast of the Annunciation at the Church of Our Lady of Angels in Silla, Spain when he noticed the tabernacle door was opened. He was greatly disturbed to see that the ciborium and all of the Consecrated Hosts were missing.

Two days later, Father Gomez received a call that the Hosts had been found. They were detected under a rock in a garden just outside the city. A group of parishioners gathered and Father Gomez led a solemn Eucharistic procession to bring the Hosts back to the Church of Our Lady of Angels.

The parishioners provided a vessel, which Fr consecrated, to hold the Sacred Hosts. They were kept in the tabernacle where they remained for many years.

In 1934, these previously stolen Hosts were brought out of the tabernacle and inspected. They were found to be completely intact with no signs of deterioration. The Archbishop of Valencia declared the phenomenon to be a miracle. They are still present and venerated at the Church of Our Lady of Angels today.


