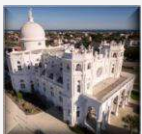

The key is to make that donation DIRECTLY to the charity. Make a call to your Retirement Plan or Investment advisor with the name and address of charity and they will do the rest. Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Merry Christmas! With Christmas falling on a Monday this year, we will be spending more time in Church in quick succession! If your children are like me when I was much younger, they probably may not find this necessarily amusing. Or maybe, you too, feel a little “churched” out yourself. That is understandable. But if you take a moment to ponder prayerfully about what Christmas is all about, you would see that we do not have enough time to give God praise and thanks for the gifts he bestows on us in Christ, whose incarnation we recall at Christmas!

Here, I defer to Saint Augustine, the erudite and saintly scholar, as he reminds us of what we celebrate when we call to mind the birth of Christ: “I tell you again: for your sake, God became man. You would have suffered eternal death, had he not been born in time. Never would you have been freed from sinful flesh, had he not taken on himself the likeness of sinful flesh. You would have suffered everlasting unhappiness, had it not been for this mercy. You would never have returned to life, had he not shared your death. You would have been lost if he had not hastened to your aid. You would have perished, had he not come.”

Christ was born to die; that is, he became man so as to redeem us from sin and death through his own death on the cross. This is the reason for our celebration and joy. “Let us then joyfully celebrate the coming of our salvation and redemption. Let us celebrate the festive day on which he who is the great and eternal day came from the great and endless day of eternity into our own short day of time” Saint Augustine continues.

In my ministry as a priest, I see how hopelessness can be an unbearable burden for so many. It can eat away one’s passion and sense of purpose in life. Christ is the hope for all. No matter how bleak the situation might seem, trust in Christ. He comes to save all; He comes to save and to help you. May God grant you perseverance as you place your hope and trust in Christ, Amen! Be merry; happy Christmas!

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

¡Feliz navidad! Dado que la Navidad cae en lunes este año, ¡pasaremos más tiempo en la Iglesia en rápida sucesión! Si sus hijos son como yo cuando era mucho más pequeño, probablemente no les resulte necesariamente divertido. O tal vez usted también se sienta un poco “religioso”. Eso es comprensible. Pero si te tomas un momento para reflexionar en oración sobre de qué se trata la Navidad, verás que no tenemos tiempo suficiente para alabar y agradecer a Dios por los dones que nos concede en Cristo, ¡cuya encarnación recordamos en Navidad!

Aquí, remito a San Agustín, el erudito y santo erudito, quien nos recuerda lo que celebramos cuando recordamos el nacimiento de Cristo: “Os lo repito: por vosotros Dios se hizo hombre. Habrías sufrido la muerte eterna, si él no hubiera nacido en el tiempo. Nunca habrías sido liberado de la carne de pecado, si él no hubiera tomado sobre sí la semejanza de carne de pecado. Habrías sufrido una infelicidad eterna si no hubiera sido por esta misericordia. Nunca habrías vuelto a la vida si él no hubiera compartido tu muerte. Habrías estado perdido si él no se hubiera apresurado en tu ayuda. Habrías muerto si él no hubiera venido.

Cristo nació para morir; es decir, se hizo hombre para redimirnos del pecado y de la muerte mediante su propia muerte en la cruz. Éste es el motivo de nuestra celebración y alegría. “Celebremos entonces con alegría la venida de nuestra salvación y redención. Celebremos el día festivo en el que Aquel que es el día grande y eterno pasó del día grande e interminable de la eternidad a nuestro corto día de tiempo”, continúa San Agustín.

En mi ministerio como sacerdote, veo cómo la desesperanza puede ser una carga insoportable para muchas personas. Puede devorar la pasión y el sentido de propósito en la vida. Cristo es la esperanza para todos. No importa cuán sombría parezca la situación, confía en Cristo. Él viene a salvar a todos; Él viene a salvaros y a ayudaros. Que Dios te conceda perseverancia al poner tu esperanza y confianza en Cristo, ¡Amén! Sé feliz; ¡feliz Navidad!

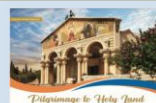

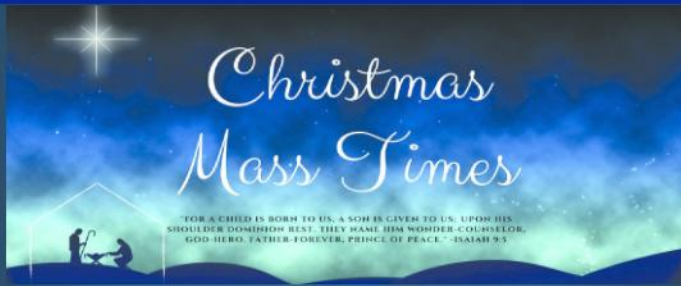


