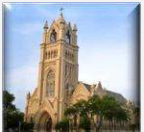

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Happy New Year! I am grateful to God for the gift of this new beginning and I pray that it would be the dawn of blessings, hope, joy and fulfillment for all of you. I am equally grateful for the past year and as we look forward to what this New Year has in store for us, I would like to invite you to embrace it with a spirit of gratitude.

Gratitude notices! This Christian virtue helps us to notice, with profound appreciation, the constant fidelity of God to all his creatures. When we are grateful, we are able to notice the blessings of God in the midst of the trials and difficulties of life. A grateful heart, for instance, gives thanks to God for the gift of rainfall, rather than complain that it is wet!

Gratitude always gives us a positive frame of mind. It helps us see what is good, positive and possible in every situation. If and when we adopt gratitude as a way of life, we become more passionate, energetic and engaged in life in a fulfilling way.

The eight heads are: entitlement, incivility, ignorance, preoccupation with self, disrespect, moodiness, contempt and ingratitude. Ingratitude is a toxic mindset that rots the soul” (p. 112).

Most people want to be loved, liked and appreciated. Cultivating the virtue of gratitude helps us to be all this and more. Grateful people are attractive and magnetic; people want to be around them. And so, “in all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus” (**1 Thessalonians 5:18**). Gratitude helps us to notice the presence of God in all things, increasing our trust in His goodness and giving us the courage we need to push on in life, no matter the circumstances. So, be grateful!

This year, make gratitude a habit. For, “it is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God, through Christ our Lord”.

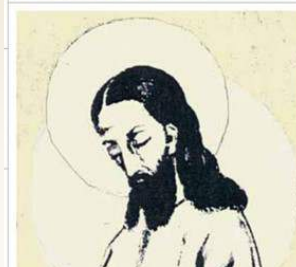
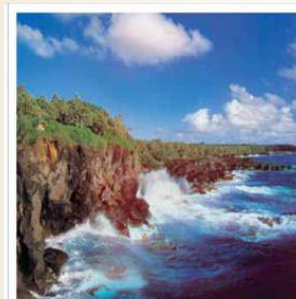
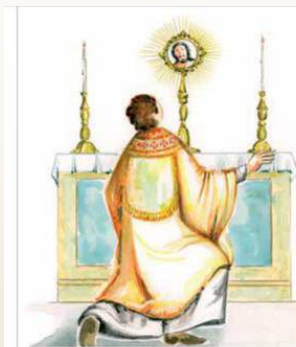
Eucharistic Miracle of

Saint-Andre De La Reunion -January 1902

On January 26, 1902, at the parish church of Saint-André, a city on the island of La Réunion (French colony), Abbot Henry Lacombe, pastor of the church, was witness to the miracle that he would recount to thousands of people during the Eucharistic Congress of Angouleme (1904), as well as to the group of priests gathered for a spiritual retreat in the town of Perigueux. The face of Jesus appeared in the Host which was for many hours witnessed by thousands of people.

Let's look at Abbot Lacombe's report: "It was January 26, 1902. We were celebrating perpetual adoration (the Forty hours devotion). The Most Holy Sacrament was exposed in the tabernacle. I began to celebrate the Mass. After the elevation, at the moment of the Our Father, my eyes were lifted toward the Host and I saw a bright halo around the rays of the monstrance. I continued to recite the prayers of Mass with great agitation in my soul but which I tried to overcome.

We came to the moment for Communion and again I looked toward the monstrance. This time I saw a human face, with lowered eyes and a crown of thorns on the forehead. What moved me the most was the dolorous expression painted on the face. The eyelashes were long and thick. I tried not to let on to the presence of the turmoil agitating inside of me. After Mass, I went to the sacristy and summoned the older children from the choir to go to the altar and closely observe the monstrance. "The children raced back and told me: 'Father, we see the head of a man in the Host. It is the good Lord revealing Himself!
