Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

As one parish, we embarked on an ambitious, albeit necessary, goal about seven years ago. It was the dream to build a centralized **Parish Life Center**, which is to serve as a spiritual hub for our parish activities, outreach ministries to the local community, and a place for our ongoing programs of faith formation especially for our children.

We reached a milestone toward the realization of this collective dream when on Monday, May 1, 2023 – the Feast Day of St. Joseph the Worker – we celebrated the official Groundbreaking Ceremony for the new parish center. Oh what a day of joy it was! As your pastor and servant-leader, I was filled with joy and gratitude to see all of us coming and working together as one family.

As we inch closer to the completion of Phase I of the project, I would like to invite all parishioners to a **Tour and Wall-Signing** ceremony on **Saturday, January 13, from 10AM to Noon (address: 2601 Ursuline St., Galveston TX 77550)**. On that day, you will all get a chance to tour our new Parish Life Center as well as sign your names (or a Scripture Passage) on the walls before the sheetrock and paints are applied later. **See page 12 for more details.**

St. Peter reminds us that “like living stones, [you should] let yourselves be built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ” (**1 Peter 2:5**). As we erect our new Parish Life Center – a physical building – let us continue to work toward building a spiritual house and a community where the love of God always takes center stage.

I am delighted to also share the good news that we will be having a new seminarian with us this spring. His name is Ryan Rivera. Ryan will be with us from January till May, before returning back to St. Mary’s Seminary in the fall to resume his formation toward the priesthood. 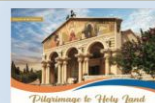

Eucharistic Miracle ONIL, SPAIN 1824

In the Eucharistic miracle of Onil, Spain on November 15, 1824, Nicolas Bernabeu who had been an altar boy in the church committed a sacrilege by stealing the monstrance containing the Blessed Sacrament. Nicolas was arrested but did not reveal where he had hidden the monstrance.

Days later, a woman from the nearby town of Tibi recovered the stolen monstrance with the consecrated Host inside in the middle of a green field.

Exactly 119 years later, on November 28, 1943,

Don Guillermo Hijarrubia, delegate of the Archbishop of Valencia, confirmed the authenticity of the miracle, verifying the COMPLETE PRESERVATION OF THE HOST.

To this day the Miraculous Host has remained intact in spite of the 182 years that have passed and may still be venerated at the Church of Saint James the Apostle in Onil. In the side chapel is the location of the monstrance, they have been held here since November 28, 1824. The chapel is called the “Nostre Senior Robot,” meaning the Stolen Lord of Onil.

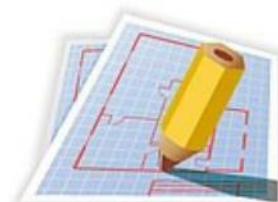

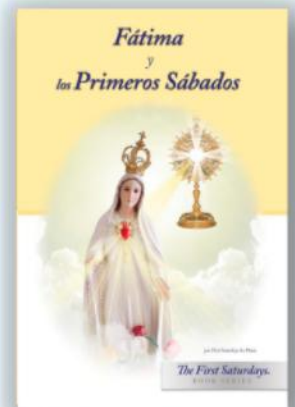
