Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Our First Reading today from the first book of the Prophet Samuel is dear to me. It is a common passage used to assist young men and women who are actively discerning a vocation to the priesthood or the religious life. This story of the young Samuel, struggling to understand the source of the voice that was beckoning to him, echoes the experience of all those who seek to do the will of God. Often times, we do not immediately understand what God is calling us to; we need the help of others to discern God's will for us.

Eli's advice to Samuel, asking him to respond thus: "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening", is the right disposition to have toward God's invitation. Yes, God truly speaks to us. We just need to have a listening heart. Spending time in prayer helps us to cultivate a listening heart. When we pray therefore, we should always strive to have some quiet moment for meditation. Using Scriptures to pray in this manner can be very helpful. Also, reading the writings of the Saints and good Christian authors on matters of the faith and our relationship with God can aid us in this venture as well.

In addition to the above, having someone to talk to occasionally about your spiritual journey is very important. Some of us are familiar with Spiritual Direction. This is one of the best kept secrets in the Catholic Church. In spiritual direction, a director – usually a clergy, a Religious, or a Lay person who has received adequate trainings - accompanies an individual in their spiritual journey through prayer and Godly counsel. While not many of us may be able to get a Spiritual Director, we can always speak with the priests or deacons in our parish occasionally about our spiritual life and life in general.

Discernment is essential in the life of every disciple. At its core, discernment is all about recognizing God's will for us in any situation we are faced with and to do it; and conversely, to reject all that is against the will of God. Here's a suggestion for you on how you might practice some discernment this week: prayerfully read today's Second Reading from St. Paul and ask yourself this question, "Am I glorifying God in my body?"

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

Nuestra primera lectura de hoy del primer libro del profeta Samuel me resulta muy querida. Es un pasaje común utilizado para ayudar a hombres y mujeres jóvenes que están discerniendo activamente una vocación sacerdocio o la vida religiosa. Esta historia del joven Samuel, que lucha por comprender el origen de la voz que lo llamaba, hace eco de la experiencia de todos aquellos que buscan hacer voluntad de Dios. Muchas veces, entendemos de inmediato a qué nos llama Dios; Necesitamos la ayuda de otros para discernir la

voluntad de Dios para nosotros.

El consejo de Elí a Samuel, pidiéndole que responda así: "Habla, Señor, que tu siervo escucha", es la disposición adecuada ante la invitación de Dios. Sí, Dios verdaderamente nos habla. Sólo necesitamos tener un corazón que escuche. Pasar tiempo en oración nos ayuda a cultivar un corazón que escucha. Por lo tanto, cuando oramos, siempre debemos esforzarnos por tener un momento de tranquilidad para meditar. Usar las Escrituras para orar de esta manera puede resultar muy útil. Además, leer los escritos de los santos y de buenos autores cristianos sobre cuestiones de la fe y nuestra relación con Dios también puede ayudarnos en esta empresa.

Además de lo anterior, es muy importante tener a alguien con quien hablar ocasionalmente sobre su viaje espiritual. Algunos de nosotros estamos familiarizados con la Dirección Espiritual. Este es uno de los secretos mejor guardados de la Iglesia Católica. En la dirección espiritual, un director (normalmente un clérigo, un religioso o un laico que ha recibido la formación adecuada) acompaña a una persona en su viaje espiritual a través de la oración y el consejo piadoso. Si bien es posible que no muchos de nosotros podamos conseguir un director espiritual, siempre podemos ocasionalmente hablar con sacerdotes o diáconos de nuestra parroquia sobre nuestra vida espiritual y nuestra vida en general.

El discernimiento es esencial en la vida de todo discípulo. En esencia, el discernimiento se trata de reconocer la voluntad de Dios para nosotros en cualquier situación que enfrentemos y hacerla; y a la inversa, rechazar todo lo que esté en contra de la voluntad de Dios. Aquí tienes una sugerencia sobre cómo puedes practicar algo de discernimiento esta semana: lee con oración la Segunda Lectura de San Pablo de hoy y hazte esta pregunta: "¿Estoy glorificando a Dios en mi cuerpo?"

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!





Eucharistic Miracle of Bordeux, France

On February 3, 1822 Fr. Pierre Noailles in a chapel in the parish of St. Eulalie, Bordeaux- scarcely had he exposed the Blessed Sacrament on the altar when the Scared Species moved slightly and the bust and head of Our Lord, surrounded by a brilliant halo were distinctly seen. They were encircled by the rays of the monstrance like a portrait in it's frame, with this difference- that the person was alive. His face was of dazzling brightness and represented a young man of about thirty, exceptionally beautiful. His hair fell in ringlets on to his shoulders, he wore a red scarf; His left hand rested on his heart and his right was stretched out towards the people who were in the chapel. He bowed from time to time and seemed then to detach himself from the circle of the monstrance, which appeared bigger than usual. people present were absorbed in The contemplation, others wept tears of joy, love and gratitude; they could not contain their sentiments of fervor.

This miraculous apparition continued for more than 20 minutes.

Even today it is possible to visit the chapel of the miracle and venerate the Monstrance of the apparition.
