Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

“This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel.” These words of Christ from today’s Gospel are as relevant today as when they were first uttered by the Son of God. How do we receive it? Do we recognize our need for repentance or do we shrug this invitation aside, thinking ourselves as righteous?

Repentance and conversion is borne of humility. It stems from the realization that in spite of our best intentions, we fall short; and that it is only through humble reliance on God’s grace that we can live righteously. Conversion consists in turning toward God. Conversely, this means turning away from all that leads us away from God.

The people of Nineveh in today’s First Reading exemplify what it means to embrace a life of repentance. They “turned from their evil way”, and God in turn blessed them. What might God be calling you to turn away from? A hidden sinful habit? Pride? Excessive worrying and lack of trust in God’s providence? Unhealthy and self-debilitating guilt? Whatever it is, are you willing to surrender it to the Lord?

Saint Paul reminds us of the urgency to embrace a life of conversion in today’s Second Reading. “The time is running out”, he says, “For the world in its present form is passing away”. The Psalmist echoes the same sentiment and exhortation in a plea to the Lord to “teach us to count our days aright that we may gain wisdom of heart” (see: **Psalm 90:12**).

Our time on earth is fleeting in comparison to eternity. How we spend eternity will be determined by how we live on earth. Our conversion should be daily. That is, we should seek to follow the Lord more closely each day. Christ, who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life, leads us to eternal life. To follow Christ is to seek to do the will of God the Father.

So today, let us ask ourselves: in what ways am I struggling to do God’s will? What/who do I need to turn away from in order for me to be able to turn toward God more faithfully? What is God calling me to repent from? This matter is urgent as it pertains to our eternal life. The choice is ours.

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

“Éste es el momento del cumplimiento. El reino de Dios está cerca. Arrepiéntanse y crean en el Evangelio”. Estas palabras de Cristo del Evangelio de hoy son tan relevantes hoy como cuando fueron pronunciadas por primera vez por el Hijo de Dios. ¿Cómo lo recibimos? ¿Reconocemos nuestra necesidad de arrepentirnos o hacemos caso omiso de esta invitación, considerándonos justos?

El arrepentimiento y la conversión nacen de la humildad. Surge de la comprensión de que, a pesar de nuestras mejores intenciones, nos quedamos cortos; y que sólo a través de una humilde confianza en la gracia de Dios podemos vivir con rectitud. La conversión consiste en volverse hacia Dios. Por el contrario, esto significa alejarse de todo lo que nos aleja de Dios.

El pueblo de Nínive en la Primera Lectura de hoy ejemplifica lo que significa abrazar una vida de arrepentimiento. Ellos “se apartaron de su mal camino”, y Dios a su vez los bendijo. ¿De qué podría Dios estar llamándote a alejarte? ¿Un hábito pecaminoso oculto? ¿Orgullo? ¿Preocupación excesiva y falta de confianza en la providencia de Dios? ¿Culpa enfermiza y autodebilitante? Sea lo que sea, ¿estás dispuesto a entregárselo al Señor?

San Pablo nos recuerda la urgencia de abrazar una vida de conversión en la Segunda Lectura de hoy. “El tiempo se acaba”, dice, “porque el mundo en su forma actual está pasando”. El salmista se hace eco del mismo sentimiento y exhortación en una súplica al Señor para que “nos enseñe a contar bien nuestros días, para que adquiramos sabiduría de corazón” (ver: Salmo 90:12).

Nuestro tiempo en la tierra es fugaz en comparación con la eternidad. La forma en que pasemos la eternidad estará determinada por cómo vivamos en la tierra. Nuestra conversión debe ser diaria. Es decir, debemos buscar seguir cada día más de cerca al Señor. Cristo, que es el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida, nos conduce a la vida eterna. Seguir a Cristo es buscar hacer la voluntad de Dios Padre.

Así que hoy preguntémosnos: ¿de qué manera estoy luchando por hacer la voluntad de Dios? ¿De qué/quién necesito alejarme para poder volverme más fielmente hacia Dios? ¿De qué me está llamando Dios a arrepentirme? Este asunto es urgente en lo que respecta a nuestra vida eterna. La elección es nuestra.

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**

Registration for RCIA and for Adult Confirmation Classes are currently ongoing.

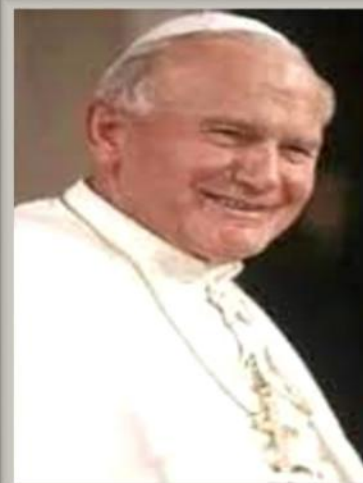

Eucharistic Miracle of SIENA ITALY, 1730

In the Basilica of San Francesco in Siena, 223 consecrated Hosts have remained intact for 276 years. (Archbishop Tiberio Borghese sealed *unconsecrated* hosts in a tin box for ten years. The scientific commission put in charge when the box was reopened found only worms and rotted fragments.) The Siena event is against any physical and biological law. The scientist Enrico Medi stated: "This direct intervention from God is the miracle [...], accomplished and maintained for centuries, to testify to the permanent reality of Christ in the Eucharistic Sacrament".



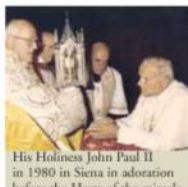

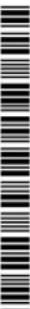
