## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today's Gospel strangely reminds me of an experience I had when I first got into the seminary. Prior to resumption, I was very excited at the thought of going to the seminary. However, I remember feeling very restless after my first night in the seminary. The seminary environment was so quiet that I was confronted with the voices that were raging inside of me! These were the voices of doubts, worries, shame, anxieties, fear, etc. Perhaps, you too could relate with this.

I had become so accustomed to the external noises without realizing how these were drowning out the voices within. There is so much in life that can provide welcome "distractions" — TV, social media, work, etc. On that day at the seminary, I was confronted with my own "inner demons" — the inner voices that were yelling about my inadequacies — and this made me feel restless and uncomfortable. My first reaction was to flee, to leave the seminary. Thank God I persisted and stayed instead.

Coming into the presence of God can sometimes be uncomfortable. In his presence, we are able to experience our vulnerabilities and brokenness. Or, to put it differently, the light of God exposes the darkness in us - that is, all that is in need of healing and restoration. That was the case with the man with an unclean spirit in today's Gospel. And in an applied sense, it is sometimes our own experience, too. How many times we have balked at the thought of going to spend some time in prayer simply because we are conscious of a grave sin in our heart! Think, for instance, of the reactions of Adam and Eve before the presence of God after their fall (see: Genesis 3:8-10). It is important to remind ourselves that in moments like this, God is not rejecting us; rather, he invites us to come to Him so as to receive His healing graces.

For the man in today's Gospel, he was made whole through the grace and mercy of Christ. In those moments when our brokenness cries out, tempting us to flee from the presence of grace, let us hold our ground in humility and with a spirit of contrition. Learn to tell God everything in prayer, especially those things you are most afraid and/or ashamed of. Don't run away from God; run towards Him and he will heal and restore you!

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

## Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

El Evangelio de hoy me recuerda extrañamente una experiencia que tuve cuando entré por primera vez al seminario. Antes de la reanudación, estaba muy entusiasmado con la idea de ir al seminario. Sin embargo, recuerdo haberme sentido muy inquieto después de mi primera noche en el seminario. ¡El ambiente del seminario era tan silencioso que me enfrenté a las voces que rugían dentro de mí! Estas eran las voces de dudas, preocupaciones, vergüenza, ansiedades, miedo, etc. Quizás tú también puedas identificarte con esto.

Me había acostumbrado tanto a los ruidos externos sin darme cuenta de cómo estos ahogaban las voces internas. Hay muchas cosas en la vida que pueden brindarnos "distracciones" bienvenidas: la televisión, las redes sociales, el trabajo, etc. Ese día en el seminario, me enfrenté a mis propios "demonios internos": las voces internas que gritaban sobre mis insuficiencias. — y esto me hizo sentir inquieto e incómodo. Mi primera reacción fue huir, abandonar el seminario. Gracias a Dios persistí y me quedé.

Entrar en la presencia de Dios a veces puede resultar incómodo. En su presencia, podemos experimentar nuestras vulnerabilidades y quebrantos. O, para decirlo de otra manera, la luz de Dios expone la oscuridad en nosotros, es todo lo que necesita sanación y restauración. Ese fue el caso del hombre con un espíritu inmundo en el Evangelio de hoy. Y en un sentido aplicado, a veces también es nuestra propia experiencia. ¡Cuántas veces nos hemos resistido a la idea de pasar un tiempo en oración simplemente porque somos conscientes de un pecado grave en nuestro corazón! Pensemos, por ejemplo, en las reacciones de Adán y Eva ante la presencia de Dios después de su caída (ver: **Génesis 3:8-10**). Es importante recordarnos que en momentos como este, Dios no nos rechaza; más bien, nos invita a venir a Él para recibir Sus gracias curativas.

Para el hombre del Evangelio de hoy, fue sanado por la gracia y la misericordia de Cristo. En esos momentos en que nuestro quebrantamiento clama, tentándonos a huir de la presencia de la gracia, mantengamos nuestra posición con humildad y con espíritu de contrición. Aprenda a contarle todo a Dios en oración, especialmente aquellas cosas de las que tiene más miedo y/o vergüenza. No huyas de Dios; ¡Corre hacia Él y él te sanará y restaurará!

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!



# RCIA AND ADULT CONTINUING FAITH FORMATION




Registration for RCIA and for **Adult Confirmation Classes are** currently ongoing.



# Eucharistic Miracle of La Scala 1782

St. Alphonsus Liguori, a doctor of the church and the founder of the Redemptorists Order was a witness to the Miracle: Every Thursday, the Most Blessed Sacrament was exposed in the monastery of the Most Holy Redeemer of Scala for public adoration. From September 11, 1732, for three consecutive months, during the solemn exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, there appeared signs of the Passion of Christ in the Host contained in the monstrance.

Bishop Santoro wrote a letter in which he described all the details related to the visions that took place in the Sacred Host that had been exposed.






