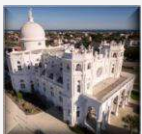

## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend, parishes throughout our archdiocese will be launching the annual **Diocesan Services Fund (DSF)**. The theme for this year – ***We are the Lord's!*** – emphasizes our communion as members of the Body of Christ, and our call to support each other, especially those who are experiencing difficult times.

Christ desires that we, his followers, should always recognize him in the poor (see: **Matthew 25:35-40**). Through the over 64 local ministries that are supported by DSF, we are able to collectively impact the lives of those who are in need in ways that are beyond the capacity of any single parish. As Cardinal DiNardo remarked, by supporting DSF, “you allow the forgotten to be remembered; the hungry to be fed; the sick, the incarcerated, and the itinerant to be ministered to”.

Last year alone, through the funds realized from the annual DSF campaign, we were able to support over 300,000 individuals through Catholic Charities; serve about 600 seniors at St. Dominic Village; provide 20,000 medical visits through San Jose Clinic; serve 17,000 inmates; and provide essential support for the formation of over 75,000 adults and young people in faith formation, 89 permanent diaconate candidates, and 3 seminarians who were ordained to the priesthood!

Our parish allotted DSF goal for this year is **\$95,000.00**. Through your great generosity, we were able to exceed our goal last year. I believe that we

can also make this year's as well. The good news is that **75 %** of the total amount raised over goal will be given back to the parish as rebate. You can scan this QR code to make a one-time donation. Also, at all the Masses this weekend, you will hear more about the different ways you can support this year's DSF campaign. May God bless you for your continued support and generosity to our brothers and sisters, through the annual DSF campaign. Amen!

## Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

Este fin de semana, las parroquias de nuestra arquidiócesis lanzarán el **Fondo de Servicios Diocesanos (DSF)** anual. El tema de este año: ***¡Somos del Señor!*** – enfatiza nuestra comunión como miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo, y nuestro llamado a apoyarnos unos a otros, especialmente a aquellos que están pasando por momentos difíciles.

Cristo desea que nosotros, sus seguidores, lo reconozcamos siempre en los pobres (ver: **Mateo 25:35-40**). A través de los más de 64 ministerios locales que cuentan con el apoyo de DSF, podemos impactar colectivamente las vidas de aquellos que lo necesitan en formas que van más allá de la capacidad de cualquier parroquia. Como señaló el Cardenal DiNardo, al apoyar al DSF, “permite que los olvidados sean recordados; los hambrientos deben ser alimentados; los enfermos, los encarcelados y los itinerantes para ser atendidos”.

Sólo el año pasado, gracias a los fondos obtenidos de la campaña anual del DSF, pudimos apoyar a más de 300.000 personas a través de Caridades Católicas; atender a unas 600 personas mayores en St. Dominic Village; brindar 20,000 visitas médicas a través de la Clínica San José; atender a 17.000 reclusos; y brindar apoyo esencial para la formación en la fe de más de 75,000 adultos y jóvenes, 89 candidatos al diaconado permanente y 3 seminaristas que fueron ordenados al sacerdocio.

La meta DSF asignada a nuestra parroquia para este año es **\$95,000.00**. Gracias a su gran generosidad, pudimos superar nuestra meta el año pasado. Creo que también podemos lograr el

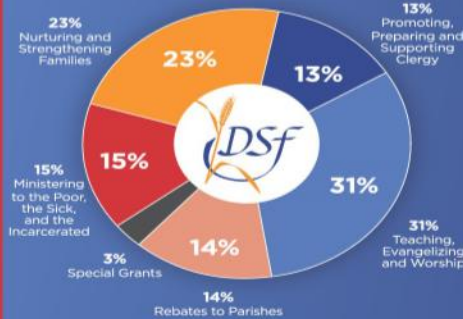

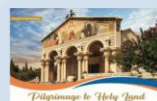

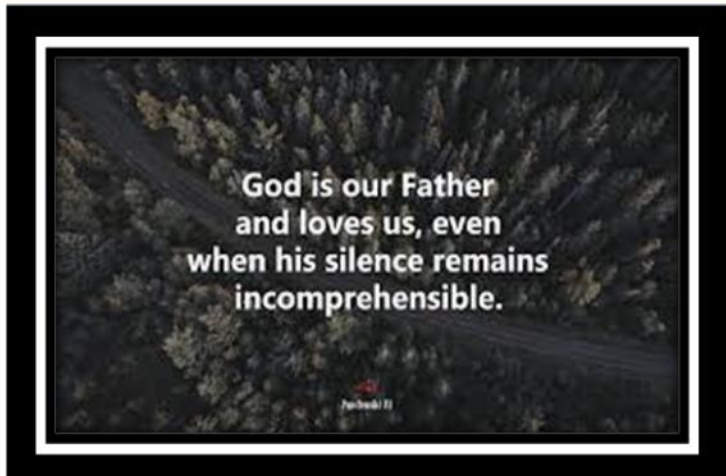

## Eucharistic Miracle at ASTI, ITALY 1718

On the morning of May 10, 1718, a priest named Father Francesco Scotto made his way to the Milliavacca Institute for Charitable Works in order to celebrate Mass. It was around 8:00 AM. Father Francesco, the celebrant, lifted the Host up with his fingers and found it actually divided precisely in half, and to his infinite astonishment, saw the longitudinal edge of the two parts appear red with blood, and moreover, the base of the chalice and the cup were stained with blood, with some small drops of blood on the corporal itself. Ambrogio, meanwhile, had arrived and observed that the consecrated Host was bleeding. He at once began to weep, and ran immediately to call the canon Argenta, confessor for the institute, Vaglio, a theologian, and Ferrero, the penitentiary, all of whom were also direct witnesses of the Miracle. At the same time, the other priests as well as three doctors from the city arrived on the scene, all of whom confirmed that the red spots were truly blood. Among those present, one was afflicted with doubt, thinking that perhaps the blood had dripped from the nose or the mouth of the priest, but some surgeons who were present, after close observation, eliminated all doubt on this issue. Afterwards, the deputy vicar along with the secretary of the curia and the vicar of the Inquisition, R. Bordino, drafted an official account of the Miracle. Another important proof of the authenticity of the Miracle comes to us from a document reporting how Monsignor Filippo Artico, Bishop of Asti, had the chalice and Host of the Miracle examined by several experts in physiology, who confirmed the hematic (blood) origin of the red stains. The Milliavacca Institute for Charitable Works has jealously preserved the relics of the Miracle: the chalice with the blood stains, the Host from the Miracle, though corrupted and reduced to a white film, the paten, the corporal, and the cup of gold-plated silver.
