

Eucharistic Miracle at LES ULMES, France 1668

On June 2, 1668 on the Feast of Corpus Christi, in the small church of Les ULMES, France, the Blessed Sacrament was exposed for public adoration, for the nearly 200 faithful in attendance. The pastor of the church began to incense the monstrance while the hymn Pange Lingua was being sung, "and having reached the stanza which in Latin means word made flesh, the shape of a man appeared in the monstrance, in place of the Host. He appeared to have light brown hair, that fell over his back, a luminous face, the hands crossed one over the other, and the body covered by a white




tunic. This apparition lasted for more than a quarter of an hour, whether on the tabernacle, where the Blessed Sacrament was exposed or on the altar when the priest, Fr. Nezan had it moved to allow a closer look to all those present." He then invited the parishioners with these words: "If there be any unbelievers among you who doubt the real presence of the body of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, let him approach. Here is Our Lord who makes Himself manifestly visible here."

At these words a great number of people approached the altar, and saw very distinctly the image of our Savior, who had the features of a young man about 25 years of age, there was a great swell of emotion among the parishioners, who shouted, "Miracle! Miracle!" The timing of the miracle was exactly when the Protestants were holding a synod in nearby Sommieres. On June 13 the pastor sent a message of what had occurred to his bishop of Andrews, Monsignor Henry Arnaulds who quickly ordered an inquiry. On June 25 a pastoral letter was

published containing the fateful description of the marvelous event.

In 1794 both the monstrance and the Host were transported to Norte Dame during the French Revolution. The bishop ordered the Host to be consumed for fear the precious host would be profaned during the revolution. Pilgrimages to honor the miracle were resumed in 1878.






