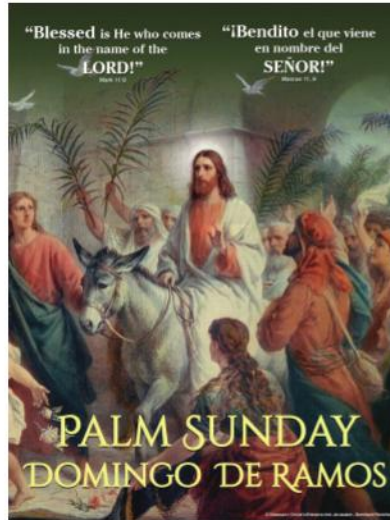

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

In our **Conversations with the Saints** Lenten series this week, we are encouraged by St. Andrew of Crete, to welcome Christ humbly and with hearts willing to do God's will.

"Let us go together to meet Christ on the Mount of Olives. Today he returns from Bethany and proceeds of his own free will toward his holy and blessed passion, to consummate the mystery of our salvation. He who came down from heaven to raise us from the depths of sin, to raise us with himself, we are told in Scripture, *above every sovereignty, authority, and power, and every other name that can be named*, now comes of his own free will to make his journey to Jerusalem. He comes without pomp or ostentation. As the psalmist says: *He will not dispute or raise his voice to make it heard in the streets*. He will be meek and humble, and he will make his entry in simplicity.

Let us run to accompany him as he hastens toward Jerusalem, and imitate those who met him then, not by covering his path with garments, olive branches or palms, but by doing all we can to prostrate ourselves before him by being humble and by trying to live as he would wish. Then we shall be able to receive the Word at his coming, and God, whom no limits can contain, will be within us.

In his humility Christ entered the dark regions of our fallen world and he is glad that he became so humble for our sake, glad that he came and lived among us and shared in our nature in order to raise us up again to himself. And even though we are told that he has now ascended above the highest heavens—the proof, surely, of his power and godhead—his love for man will never rest until he has raised our earthbound nature from glory to glory, and made it one with his own in heaven.

So let us spread before his feet, not garments or soulless olive branches, which delight the eye for a few hours and then wither, but ourselves, clothed in his grace, or rather, clothed completely in him. We who have been baptized into Christ must ourselves be the garments that we spread before him. Now that the crimson stains of our sins have been washed away in the saving waters of baptism and we have become white as pure wool, let us present the conqueror of death, not with mere branches of palms but with the real rewards of his victory. Let our souls take the place of the welcoming branches as we join today in the children's holy song: *Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Blessed is the king of Israel.*"

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

En nuestra serie de Cuaresma Conversaciones con los Santos de esta semana, San Andrés de Creta nos anima a recibir a Cristo con humildad y con corazones dispuestos a hacer la voluntad de Dios.

"Vayamos juntos al encuentro de Cristo en el Monte de los Olivos. Hoy regresa de Betania y procede por su propia voluntad hacia su santa y bendita pasión, para consumir el misterio de nuestra salvación. El que descendió del cielo para levantarnos de las profundidades del pecado, para levantarnos consigo mismo, se nos dice en las Escrituras, por encima de toda soberanía, autoridad y poder, y de todo otro nombre que pueda nombrarse, ahora viene por sí mismo. libre albedrío para hacer su viaje a Jerusalén. Viene sin pompa ni ostentación. Como dice el salmista: No disputará ni alzaré la voz para hacerse oír en las calles. Será manso y humilde, y hará su entrada con sencillez. Alegrémonos, pues, porque aquel que es manso y que se eleva por encima del crepúsculo de nuestra más baja vileza se ha presentado mansamente a nosotros, para venir a nosotros y vive con nosotros, para que él, por su parte, pueda familiarizarnos con él.

Corramos para acompañarlo mientras se apresura hacia Jerusalén, e imitemos a quienes lo encontraron entonces, no cubriendo su camino con ropas, ramas de olivo o palmas, sino haciendo todo lo que podamos para postrarnos ante él, siendo humildes y esforzándonos. vivir como quisiera. Entonces podremos recibir la Palabra en su venida, y Dios, a quien ningún límite puede contener, estará dentro de nosotros.

En su humildad, Cristo entró en las regiones oscuras de nuestro mundo caído y está contento de haberse vuelto tan humilde por nuestro bien, contento de haber venido y vivido entre nosotros y haber compartido nuestra naturaleza para levantarnos nuevamente a sí mismo. Y aunque se nos dice que ahora ha ascendido a los más altos cielos (prueba, sin duda, de su poder y divinidad), su amor por el hombre nunca descansará hasta que haya elevado nuestra naturaleza terrestre de gloria en gloria y la haya convertido en una sola. con los suyos en el cielo.

Por tanto, extendamos ante sus pies, no vestidos ni ramas de olivo sin alma, que deleitan la vista durante algunas horas y luego se marchitan, sino nosotros mismos, revestidos de su gracia, o, mejor dicho, revestidos completamente de él. Nosotros, los que hemos sido bautizados en Cristo, debemos ser nosotros mismos las vestiduras que extendemos delante de él. Ahora que las manchas carmesíes de nuestros pecados han sido lavadas en las aguas salvadoras del bautismo y nos hemos vuelto blancos como pura lana, presentemos al vencedor de la muerte, no con meras ramas de palma sino con las verdaderas recompensas de su victoria. Dejemos que nuestras almas tomen el lugar de las ramas de bienvenida al unirnos hoy al canto santo de los niños: Bendito el que viene en el nombre del Señor. Bendito el rey de Israel".

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**

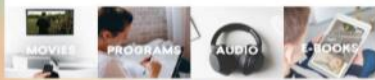

These scam calls will pretend to be the Lone Star Help Desk by using the caller ID "Lone Star Card Help Desk," or using the Lone Star Help Desk phone number (800-777-7328). Then they'll ask for your information in exchange for new or increased benefits.

Do NOT give your personal information or Lone Star Card details to an unsolicited call. To confirm you are speaking with Texas Health and Human Services, you should directly call the number on the back of your Lone Star card.

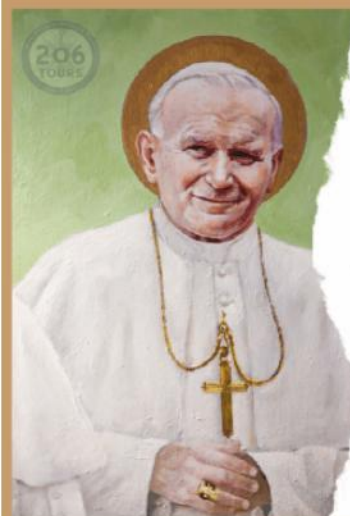

It is still possible today to see the miraculous imprint left by the Host which fell on the steps of the altar in the Caetani Chapel of Santa Pudenziana Church in Rome. The imprint on the step was left when the Host fell from the hands of a priest who, while celebrating Mass, began to doubt the Real Presence of Christ in the sacrament of the Eucharist.

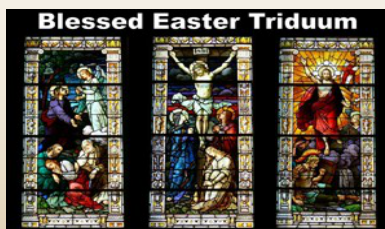
