

Message from the Pastor

Mensaje del Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today, the Church celebrates **Divine Mercy Sunday.** The mercy of God is made manifest in and through Christ who offered himself on the cross, taking upon himself our sins, so as to reconcile us back to God and to win for us the gift of eternal life. The Church therefore invites us to sing praises of thanksgiving to God in the Optional Sequence before the Gospel reading today: *Christians, to the Paschal Victim offer your thankful praises! A Lamb the sheep redeems; Christ, who only is sinless, reconciles sinners to the Father. ... Christ indeed from death is risen, our new life obtaining. Have mercy, victor King, ever reigning. Amen. Alleluia.*

Alleluia – that is, *praise God!* – is our song indeed. The abundance of the recitation of alleluia throughout the Easter Season underscores our attempts to praise God continuously for His gift of salvation to us in Christ. Christ is our peace. He is the one who is capable of bringing ultimate resolution to all the troubles that plague us.

In his encounter with the Apostles in today's Gospel, he brings peace to their frightened spirits, crushed with the guilt of *abandoning* him during his passion and death on the cross. We all can identify with the Apostles, for we too, betray Christ through our lack of charity, our selfishness, arrogance, apathy for the things of God, and the myriad of ways we sin against God and our neighbors. Yet, he comes to us in mercy to redeem us.

To all who approach God with great trust and expectant faith especially on this Divine Mercy Sunday, he has promised to lavish them with the extraordinary grace of "complete forgiveness of sins and [the] punishment" due to sins. We can obtain this grace by receiving Holy Communion in a state of grace and by participating in the Divine Mercy devotion, which can be found by doing a simple (Google) search on the internet.

God never tires of showering his love and mercy upon us. We simply need to trust and ask. Here is a simple formula to encourage us to always trust in God's mercy: the **A B C of Mercy** –

A – Ask for mercy;

B – Be merciful yourself; and

C – Completely trust *in God*.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

La misericordia de Dios se manifiesta en y por Cristo, que se ofreció a sí mismo en la cruz, tomando sobre sí nuestros pecados, para reconciliarnos con Dios y ganarnos el don de la vida eterna. Por lo tanto, la Iglesia nos invita a cantar alabanzas de acción de gracias a Dios en la Secuencia Opcional antes de la lectura del Evangelio de hoy: ¡Cristianos, ofrezcan a la Víctima Pascual sus alabanzas agradecidas! Un Cordero la oveja redime; Cristo, el único sin pecado, reconcilia a los pecadores con el Padre. ...Cristo ciertamente de entre los muertos ha resucitado, obteniendo nuestra nueva vida. Ten piedad, rey victorioso, reinando siempre. Amén. Aleluya.

Aleluya – es decir, jalabado sea Dios! – es nuestra canción de hecho. La abundancia de la recitación del Aleluya a lo largo del tiempo pascual subraya nuestros intentos de alabar a Dios continuamente por su regalo de salvación para nosotros en Cristo. Cristo es nuestra paz. El es quien es capaz de traer la solución definitiva a todos los problemas que nos acosan.

En su encuentro con los Apóstoles en el Evangelio de hoy, trae paz a sus espíritus atemorizados, aplastados por la culpa de haberlo abandonado durante su pasión y muerte en la cruz. Todos podemos identificarnos con los Apóstoles, porque nosotros también traicionamos a Cristo por nuestra falta de caridad, nuestro egoísmo, arrogancia, apatía por las cosas de Dios y la infinidad de formas en que pecamos contra Dios y nuestro prójimo. Sin embargo, él viene a nosotros en misericordia para redimirnos.

A todos los que se acercan a Dios con gran confianza y fe expectante, especialmente en este Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, él les ha prometido prodigarles la extraordinaria gracia del "completo perdón de los pecados y [el] castigo" debido a los pecados. Podemos obtener esta gracia recibiendo la Sagrada Comunión en estado de gracia y participando en la devoción a la Divina Misericordia, que se puede encontrar haciendo una simple búsqueda (Google) en Internet.

Dios nunca se cansa de derramar sobre nosotros su amor y misericordia. Simplemente necesitamos confiar y preguntar. Aquí hay una fórmula simple para animarnos a confiar siempre en la misericordia de Dios: el A B C de la Misericordia –

A – Pide misericordia;

B – Sé misericordioso contigo mismo; y

C – Confiar completamente en Dios.

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!




