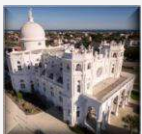

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

It is amazing how the little things sometimes make the greatest impact! For me, it is the joy of being able to say and sing “Alleluia!” once again. *Alleluia*, that is, praise the Lord, for indeed his mercies last forever!

Our First Reading today forms a part of St. Peter’s Easter proclamation. This time, he invites his hearers to repent. There is never a time that anyone of us is not in need of repentance! Essentially, repentance means *turning towards God and following in his paths more faithfully*.

It is easy for most of us to ignore the call to repentance. After all, to repent, speaking ordinarily, is to suggest the need to turn away from one’s sins and to live aright before God. This is true, but it is safe to say that when one is not conscious of grave sins, the idea of repenting might seem foreign. Yet, there is so much more we need to turn away from in order to follow God more faithfully. It could be doubt, fear, unbelief, confusion and the likes. While suchlike phenomena may not necessarily qualify as sins but could nonetheless lead to sinning, they sometimes could also keep us from trusting and following God faithfully.

A good example is from a reference in today’s Gospel that some of us might miss. The very first sentence alludes to the experience of the two disciples on their way to Emmaus (see: Luke 24:13-35). From all indications, they were walking away from Jerusalem – and by extension, from Christ – because they thought he was a failure. Also, they had difficulties believing in the account of the women and the other disciples who shared that Christ has truly risen (See: Luke 22:22-24). Their doubt was leading them away from the right path.

How often we, too, are like these disciples. Blinded by our doubts, fears or ego, we walk away from the right path. It was through their encounter with Christ that they were able to repent – that is, turn around – and get back on the right path! As we continue our Easter journey, let us ask the Holy Spirit to show us what we need to repent from in order to follow God more faithfully. Happy repenting!

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

¡Es sorprendente cómo las pequeñas cosas a veces causan el mayor impacto! Para mí es la alegría de poder decir y cantar “¡Aleluya!” una vez más. ¡Aleluya, es decir, alabado sea el Señor, porque en verdad sus misericordias duran para siempre!

Nuestra Primera Lectura de hoy forma parte de la proclamación pascual de San Pedro. Esta vez invita a sus oyentes a arrepentirse. ¡Nunca hay un momento en el que ninguno de nosotros no necesite arrepentirse! Básicamente, el arrepentimiento significa *volverse hacia Dios y seguir más fielmente sus caminos*.

Para la mayoría de nosotros es fácil ignorar el llamado al arrepentimiento. Después de todo, arrepentirse, hablando normalmente, es sugerir la necesidad de alejarse de los pecados y vivir rectamente ante Dios. Esto es cierto, pero es seguro decir que cuando uno no es consciente de sus pecados graves, la idea de arrepentirse puede parecer extraña. Sin embargo, hay mucho más de lo que debemos alejarnos para seguir a Dios más fielmente. Podría ser duda, miedo, incredulidad, confusión y cosas por el estilo. Si bien fenómenos similares no necesariamente califican como pecados, pero aun así pueden llevarnos a pecar, a veces también pueden impedirnos confiar y seguir fielmente a Dios.

Un buen ejemplo es una referencia del Evangelio de hoy que algunos de nosotros podríamos pasar por alto. La primera frase alude a la experiencia de los dos discípulos camino a Emaús (ver: Lucas 24,13-35). Según todos los indicios, se estaban alejando de Jerusalén –y, por extensión, de Cristo– porque pensaban que él era un fracaso. Además, tuvieron dificultades para creer en el relato de las mujeres y los demás discípulos que compartieron que Cristo verdaderamente ha resucitado (Ver: Lucas 22:22-24). Su duda los estaba alejando del camino correcto.

¡Cuántas veces también nosotros somos como estos discípulos! Cegados por nuestras dudas, miedos o ego, nos alejamos del camino correcto. Fue a través de su encuentro con Cristo que pudieron arrepentirse – es decir, dar la vuelta – ¡y volver al camino correcto! Mientras continuamos nuestro camino pascual, pidamos al Espíritu Santo que nos muestre de qué debemos arrepentirnos para seguir a Dios más fielmente. ¡Feliz arrepentimiento!

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**
