Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

What is in a name? A name both connotes as well as denotes. Especially when it comes to the names of persons, they are usually filled with meaning, history, purpose, intention, and the like. The name of God, however, is associated with God's essence – that is, who God is.

Scripture recounts the call of Moses in Exodus chapter 3. During that encounter, Moses inquires about the name of God, to which God responds saying, "I AM who I AM", *Yhwh* in Hebrew (Exodus 3:14). In its original Hebrew, the name given to Moses by God can also be translated as "I AM" or "I will be(come)". God's name therefore, connotes and denotes God's essence as the Ground and Foundation of all that is.

The name of God is holy and has authority and power. To call on God's name therefore, is to invoke God's awesome glory and essence. Hence, we are exhorted not to use God's name in vain; that is, to be reverent whenever we invoke God's name.

The Divine name in all its majesty, essence and might, has been given to us in Christ Jesus so "that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (Philippians 2:10-11). That is to say, there is no name other than the name of Jesus by which we shall be saved! (See: Acts 4:12). In today's First Reading, we are given an account of the saving power of the name of Jesus.

So when you think of the name, Jesus Christ, what comes to mind? Who comes to your mind? An idea, an abstract being or the living Lord of heaven and earth?

Through Jesus Christ, we have been granted full access to (the name of) God. This is why we are rightly called the *children of God*, as we are reminded in today's Second Reading. Christ, the Good Shepherd, calls each one of us by name, to lead us to our home with our Heavenly Father. May we always respond with joy to who we are – God's children – even as we faithfully follow wherever the Savior calls us to. Amen!

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

¿Qué hay en un nombre? Un nombre connota y denota al mismo tiempo. Especialmente cuando se trata de nombres de personas, generalmente están llenos de significado, historia, propósito, intención y cosas por el estilo. El nombre de Dios, sin embargo, está asociado con la esencia de Dios, es decir, quién es Dios.

La Escritura relata el llamado de Moisés en Éxodo capítulo 3. Durante ese encuentro, Moisés pregunta sobre el nombre de Dios, a lo que Dios responde diciendo: "YO SOY el que SOY", *Yhwh* en hebreo (Éxodo 3:14). En su original hebreo, el nombre dado a Moisés por Dios también puede traducirse como "YO SOY" o "Yo seré (vendré)". Por lo tanto, el nombre de Dios connota y denota la esencia de Dios como la Base y el Fundamento de todo lo que existe.

El nombre de Dios es santo y tiene autoridad y poder. Por lo tanto, invocar el nombre de Dios es invocar la maravillosa gloria y esencia de Dios. Por tanto, se nos exhorta a no usar el nombre de Dios en vano; es decir, ser reverentes cada vez que invoquemos el nombre de Dios. El nombre Divino en toda su majestad, esencia y poder, nos ha sido dado en Cristo Jesús para "que al nombre de Jesús se doble toda rodilla en el cielo, y en la tierra, y debajo de la tierra, y toda lengua confiese que Jesucristo es el Señor, para gloria de Dios Padre" (Filipenses 2:10-11). Es decir, ¡no hay otro nombre que el de Jesús por el cual seremos salvos! (Ver: Hechos 4:12). En la Primera Lectura de hoy, se nos da cuenta del poder salvador del nombre de Jesús.

Entonces, cuando piensas en el nombre Jesucristo, ¿qué te viene a la mente? ¿Quién te viene a la mente? ¿Una idea, un ser abstracto o el Señor vivo del cielo y de la tierra?

A través de Jesucristo, se nos ha concedido pleno acceso a (el nombre de) Dios. Por eso con razón se nos llama *hijos de Dios*, como se nos recuerda en la segunda lectura de hoy. Cristo, el Buen Pastor, nos llama a cada uno de nosotros por nuestro nombre, para conducirnos a nuestro hogar con nuestro Padre Celestial. Que siempre respondamos con gozo a quienes somos –los hijos de Dios– incluso cuando sigamos fielmente a dondequiera que el Salvador nos llame. ¡Amén!

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**
