Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Last week's Gospel introduced the vine imagery to describe our relationship with Christ as members of the Mystical Body of Christ. That theme continues this week with a focus on love. "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends". Christ did that for us! Throughout his public ministry, and by his Passion, Death and Resurrection, he shows us concretely God's unmerited love for us that has no limit!

This love has been bestowed upon us through Christ, in the Holy Spirit, giving us the ability to address God as "Abba, Father!" That is to say, through Christ, we have been granted intimacy with the Divine life: "I no longer call you slaves, because a slave does not know what his master is doing. I have called you friends, because I have told you everything I have heard from my Father".

The question for you and I is this: "what will our response be?" Are we going to accept the gracious offer of love from God or are we going to despise it? Will you seek to grow in friendship and intimacy with God? We cannot dillydally about this; our response has to be clear, consistent, joyful and passionate.

Christ, in today's Gospel, is direct: "You are my friends if you do what I command you". This is not so much a condition for friendship as it is a statement of fact. As humans, one good way we show that we love, care and respect someone is by letting them see through our words and actions, that what matters to them, matters to us. That is, that we are paying attention to them. This is therefore what Christ is speaking to: if we claim to love God and seek to live as friends of God, we should show it by taking the words of God seriously, for start.

God takes the initiative. In Christ, he speaks very clearly. "In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as expiation for our sins". In Christ, we see that there is no limit to God's love for us. God, in turn, invites us to commit in our friendship with God, and to let this extend to those we encounter. The ball is in our court! What say you?

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

El Evangelio de la semana pasada introdujo las imágenes de la vid para describir nuestra relación con Cristo como miembros del Cuerpo Místico de Cristo. Ese tema continúa esta semana con un enfoque en el amor. "Nadie tiene mayor amor que este: dar la vida por los amigos". ¡Cristo hizo eso por nosotros! ¡A lo largo de su ministerio público, y por su Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección, nos muestra concretamente el amor inmerecido de Dios por nosotros que no tiene límites!

Este amor nos ha sido otorgado a través de Cristo, en el Espíritu Santo, dándonos la capacidad de dirigirnos a Dios como "¡Abba, Padre!" Es decir, a través de Cristo, se nos ha concedido la intimidad con la vida Divina: "Ya no os llamo esclavos, porque el esclavo no sabe lo que hace su amo. Os he llamado amigos, porque os he contado todo lo que he oído de mi Padre".

La pregunta para usted y para mí es esta: "¿cuál será nuestra respuesta?" ¿Vamos a aceptar la generosa oferta de amor de Dios o la vamos a despreciar? ¿Buscarás crecer en amistad e intimidad con Dios? No podemos perder el tiempo con esto; nuestra respuesta tiene que ser clara, coherente, alegre y apasionada.

Cristo, en el evangelio de hoy, es directo: "vosotros sois mis amigos si hacéis lo que os mando". Esto no es tanto una condición para la amistad sino una declaración de hecho. Como seres humanos, una buena manera de demostrar que amamos, nos preocupamos y respetamos a alguien es permitiéndole ver a través de nuestras palabras y acciones que lo que le importa a él también nos importa a nosotros. Es decir, que les estamos prestando atención. Por lo tanto, esto es a lo que Cristo está hablando: si afirmamos amar a Dios y buscamos vivir como amigos de Dios, debemos demostrarlo tomando en serio las palabras de Dios, para empezar.

Dios toma la iniciativa. En Cristo, habla muy claramente. "En esto está el amor: no en que nosotros hayamos amado a Dios, sino en que él nos amó y envió a su Hijo como expiación por nuestros pecados". En Cristo, vemos que no hay límite para el amor de Dios por nosotros. Dios, a su vez, nos invita a comprometernos en nuestra amistad con Dios y a dejar que esto se extienda a aquellos con quienes nos encontramos. ¡La pelota está en nuestro tejado! ¿Lo que usted dice?

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**
