Mensaje del Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Let us give God thanks for mothers everywhere as we celebrate them in a special way this weekend. Mothers nurture life and through their maternal devotion to their family, we see a glimpse of God's faithful and limitless love for us, his children.

This weekend, also, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Ascension of Christ into heaven. The Evangelist once recalled an episode in the Gospel when Christ evoked the imagery of a mother's love to impress upon us God's desire to gather us together into his kingdom in spite of our obstinacy: "Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how many times I yearned to gather your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, but you were unwilling!" (Luke 13:34).

We are the new Jerusalem, called to be members of the Body of Christ. And like a mother, Christ wants to gather us with him in heaven. In our Opening Prayer today, we pray to God the Father as we acknowledge that "the Ascension of Christ your Son is our exaltation, and, where the Head has gone before in glory, the Body is called to follow in hope". Let us therefore follow in obedience, like loving children, the path that Christ sets before us until by his grace, we are with him and all the saints in the heavenly kingdom.

And as we celebrate mothers today, let us keep in mind those among them who are experiencing pain and loss. Our local **Pregnancy Help Center** is dedicated to assisting mothers and families who are struggling with 'difficult' pregnancies. In order to assist them in their important work of supporting and promoting the Gospel of life, we urge you to consider participating in their annual **Baby Bottle Boomerang** campaign, which kicks off this weekend.

Finally, we are grateful to everyone who thus far has contributed to the annual Diocesan Services Fund (**DSF**) campaign. One of the major goals of the DSF is to nurture and strengthen families through social and pastoral ministries. We invite everyone to prayerfully consider making a donation in support of the DSF. 



When the land was placed for sale in 2021, we promised to build a Marian Grotto upon securing the land for the future of the CRC. A Marian Grotto was part of our strategic plan in the future. In the summer of 2022, the land was secured. In March 2023, we cleared the trail, and construction began in November 2023. 
