

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

On Saturday, June 1st, our Local Church will be blessed with three newly ordained priests. One of them is Deacon Viet Nguyen, who was with us only two years ago for his Pastoral Assignment. He is joined by his other two Deacon brothers – Deacons Luis Armas and David Ramirez. The ordination Mass will take place at the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart, starting at 10AM, with Cardinal DiNardo presiding. For those interested, the Mass will be livestreamed on the archdiocesan website - www.archgh.org/live.

Following his ordination, Rev. Viet will be with us on **Sunday**, **June 9**th, to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving at **St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica** at 12:30PM. There will be a reception after the Mass at the KC Hall on Winnie, where we can all celebrate with Rev. Viet as well as receive his blessings as a newly ordained priest. Let us keep Viet and his brother deacons in our prayers as they prepare to joyfully embrace the Priestly vocation.

It is through the hands of the priest, aided by God's grace of course, that the Church continues to have the Eucharist. As. St. John Chrysostom reminds us, "It is not the man who is responsible for the offerings as they become Christ's Body and Blood; it is Christ Himself who was crucified for us. The standing figure belongs to the priest who speaks these words. The power and the grace belong to God. 'This is My Body,' he says. And these words transform the offerings."

Christ, who is truly present in the Holy Eucharist, continues to invite us to receive Him worthily at Mass, and to worship Him reverently in the Eucharist. On **Sunday, June 2**nd, the feast of **Corpus Christi**, Cardinal DiNardo will be in our parish to celebrate the **10AM Mass** at **St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica** to conclude the **Eucharistic Pilgrimage** for the ongoing **National Eucharistic Revival**. And immediately after the Mass, there will be a solemn procession from St. Mary's to Sacred Heart, followed by Eucharistic Exposition and Adoration.

Our Savior Jesus Christ, who lovingly gives us himself in the Blessed Sacrament, beckons on us to come and spend time with him. So, come; let us adore him!



Around the Parish

What Is a Eucharistic Pilgrimage?

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage is a truly unique initiative. This is something NEW—a beautiful fusion of the journey TO Jesus and the journey WITH Jesus. What's more, it is an adventure that all Catholics can do together, either by interior disposition or physical accompaniment.

This is the birth of something remarkable. Join us as we accompany Jesus in the Eucharist from the north, south, east, and west edges of our country, stopping at many holy sites and churches along the way. Together we will journey with Christ on his way to the 10th National Eucharistic Congress, where he comes to encounter his people anew.

St. Juan Diego Route

The southern arm of the Pilgrimage, dubbed the "Juan Diego Route" will depart from the tip of Texas in Brownsville, wind around the Gulf of Mexico—an area chosen for its deep Catholic roots. Catholics in the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston will have a special opportunity to embrace and welcome the 2024 National Eucharistic Pilgrimage the weekend after Memorial Day in 2024.
