HOW CLOSE ARE WE TO OUR CAMPAIGN GOALS? Our campaign is phased to make the goals achievable and for Phase 1, we set out to raise \$5.5 Million in four years to refurbish the east-end of our existing building at the school into our new centralized Parish Parish Life Center (PLC). Right now, we are **LESS THAN ONE MILLION DOLLARS** to accomplishing this goal!!!

This four-year Capital Campaign will end September of 2025. We are working diligently to meet our campaign goal of \$5.5 Million by this date. The global pandemic caused an increase in the cost of construction, which caused an increase in the true cost of our current capital campaign project, but we are confident that if we can reach our current goal, it would greatly help with paying for the cost of this first phase of our Capital Campaign. All that remains of this goal is \$960,000 in pledges. Join us with a pledge today and we can complete this goal prior to the end date.

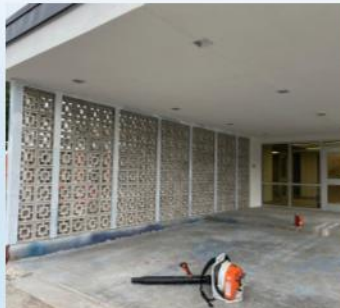

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This week, I would like to continue our reflection on the Holy Eucharist, with particular focus on its nature both as gift and mystery. In the Holy Eucharist, we receive Christ himself. It is hard to put in words the unquantifiable nature of what and Whom we receive in the Eucharist. To give us a perspective, St. Paul reminds us that in Christ, God has given us everything: “For however many are the promises of God, their Yes is in him; therefore, the Amen from us also goes through him to God for glory” (2 Corinthians 1:20).

Everything that the Father has promised us has been fulfilled and made available to us in and through Christ! Now, we live in anticipation of the fullness of God’s promise to all his faithful – the gift of life everlasting in the company of all the holy ones. Christ, our Redeemer and brother, accompanies us on our pilgrimage in the Eucharist. He is food for the journey.

The gift of the Eucharist invites us to contemplate reverently the mystery it holds. Christ, our Savior, has made it possible for us to receive him and the fruits of his saving sacrifice, offered once for all at Calvary, in the Holy Eucharist. In the Eucharist, we receive the pledge of Christ’s love for us, which is intimately connected with the priesthood. Christ, in order “never to depart from his own and to make them sharers in his Passion, he instituted the Eucharist as the memorial of his death and Resurrection, and commanded his apostles to celebrate it until his return; “thereby he constituted them priests of the New Testament” (CCC §1337).

We are grateful to God for the gift of the Priesthood for through the hands of the priests, God provides the Eucharist to his Church. Our archdiocese was blessed with three newly ordained priests – Frs. Luis Armas, David Ramirez and Viet Nguyen. Fr. Viet, who did his Pastoral Year in our parish a little over two years ago, returned to our parish community this weekend to offer a Mass of thanksgiving. What a privilege for us all to receive the blessings of a newly ordained priest! Let us keep Fr. Viet and his fellow newly ordained brother priests in our prayers, that God may fill their priestly ministry with his blessings. Amen!

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

Esta semana, me gustaría continuar nuestra reflexión sobre la Sagrada Eucaristía, con especial atención a su naturaleza como don y misterio. En la Sagrada Eucaristía recibimos al mismo Cristo. Es difícil expresar con palabras la naturaleza incuantificable de qué y a quién recibimos en la Eucaristía. Para darnos una perspectiva, San Pablo nos recuerda que en Cristo, Dios nos lo ha dado todo: “Por muchas que sean las promesas de Dios, su Sí está en él; por tanto, el Amén de nosotros pasa también por él a Dios para gloria” (2 Corintios 1:20).

¡Todo lo que el Padre nos ha prometido se ha cumplido y puesto a nuestra disposición en y a través de Cristo! Ahora vivimos anticipando la plenitud de la promesa de Dios a todos sus fieles: el don de la vida eterna en compañía de todos los santos. Cristo, nuestro Redentor y hermano, nos acompaña en nuestra peregrinación en la Eucaristía. Él es alimento para el viaje.

El don de la Eucaristía nos invita a contemplar con reverencia el misterio que encierra. Cristo, nuestro Salvador, ha hecho posible que lo recibamos a él y a los frutos de su sacrificio salvador, ofrecido una vez para siempre en el Calvario, en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Viet, quien realizó su Año Pastoral en nuestra parroquia hace poco más de dos años, regresó a nuestra comunidad parroquial este fin de semana para ofrecer una Misa de acción de gracias. ¡Qué privilegio para todos nosotros recibir las bendiciones de un sacerdote recién ordenado! Mantengamos al P. Viet y sus hermanos sacerdotes recién ordenados en nuestras oraciones, para que Dios llene su ministerio sacerdotal con sus bendiciones. ¡Amén!

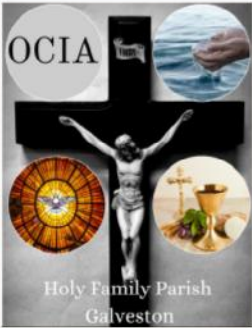

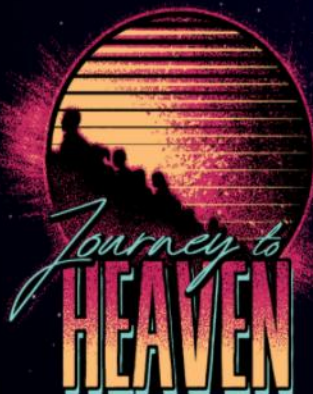
