

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend we celebrate fathers everywhere. God is our Heavenly Father, "from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named" (Ephesians 3:15). Let us pray for all fathers that they may always strive to live out their vocation to love, serve and protect their families and communities in a spirit of joy, and so mirror the love of our Heavenly Father in their daily lives.

We are very delighted to welcome the seminarians who will be spending part of their summer in our parish as they take part in the Propaedeutic Program. Through this program, these young men will be assisted with the basic foundation they need to help prepare them for the program of priestly formation in in the seminary.

Also in our midst are two other seminarians – Mr. Theodore Birkofer and Mr. Ryan Berger – who are here for the Clinical Pastoral Education program (CPE) at UTMB. The aim of CPE is to equip seminarians in formation with the pastoral skills needed to minister the love and healing graces of Christ to those who are sick. While they are with us, Mr. Theodore and Ryan will be mostly engaged at UTMB and as a result, might not be as visible in the parish. I have therefore included their short autobiographies and pictures in this bulletin (see p. 5) to help us know them a little better. Please keep them and all who are discerning a vocation to the priesthood and the Religious Life in your prayers.

These seminarians are responding to God's invitation to embrace spiritual fatherhood through the priesthood. Priests are fathers in the order of grace. Through their varied ministry and the administration of the sacraments, they beget (spiritual) life (in baptism) as well as provide guidance and paternal accompaniment especially during pivotal moments in the lives of those they serve. St. Paul attests to the validity of this form of fatherhood when writing to the Corinthian community, he acknowledged that he became [their] father in Christ Jesus through the gospel (1 Cor. 4:15). This is fatherhood in the order of grace!

Christ continues to call young men to embrace spiritual fatherhood through the priesthood. Let us echo Christ's invitation by asking the young men we encounter – especially those in our families – this question: "Have you asked yourself what God might be calling you to in life?"

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

















OCIA and Adult Confirmation
