Message from the Pastor

Mensaje del Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

How often we try to drag God into our worrying feats! Sometimes, as we deal with the challenges of life, we feel isolated and wonder if God is around. In such moments it is common for many of us to cry out, "God, where are you?" Or "God, why me?"

Of course, God is always with us, even when we do not feel his presence! The question is whether we have faith and trust in God or not. Today's Gospel presents us with powerful reminders of the lot of those who place their trust in God. Both miracles recounted in the Gospel bespeak of the goodness of God and of the faith of the recipients.

Our God sees us even when no one else does, making us feel isolated in our pain and struggles. The woman afflicted with hemorrhages experienced isolation as her condition would have made her ritually unclean to participate in temple worship. (For examples of the ritual prohibitions associated with the flow of blood in the Old Testament, see Leviticus 12:2-5 and 15:19). In addition, her condition was a cause of great shame, not to talk of the financial burden to her! Yet, she braved the odds and reached out to "touch" Jesus. And as for the little girl who, by the way, was also identified as being 12 years old, it was her father's persistent faith – which stood against the faithlessness of the crowd – that brought her the "touch" of Jesus, the touch that restores to new life.

The woman who had suffered for as long as this little girl had lived, experienced the help of God, as did the little girl! In a period where women and children often take the backseat, we are reminded that no one is insignificant in the sight of God. God sees us all and yes, he knows of our struggles. He calls us to have faith and to trust in him, no matter what betides. And remember, through the sacraments of the Church, we experience the healing touch and help of our God.

So, whether it is you or someone you care about that is going through a difficult time, remember this truth: "if you trust in the Lord always, he will make you a WARRIOR, not a WORRIER, as you face life's challenges". God bless you!

A veces, al afrontar los desafíos de la vida, nos sentimos aislados y nos preguntamos si Dios está cerca. En esos momentos es común que muchos de nosotros gritemos: "Dios, ¿dónde estás?" O "Dios, ¿por qué yo?"

¡Por supuesto, Dios siempre está con nosotros, incluso cuando no sentimos su presencia! La pregunta es si tenemos fe y confianza en Dios o no. El Evangelio de hoy nos presenta poderosos recordatorios de la suerte de quienes ponen su confianza en Dios. Ambos milagros relatados en el Evangelio hablan de la bondad de Dios y de la fe de quienes los reciben.

Nuestro Dios nos ve incluso cuando nadie más lo hace, haciéndonos sentir aislados en nuestro dolor y luchas. La mujer afectada por hemorragias experimentó aislamiento ya que su condición la habría hecho ritualmente impura para participar en la adoración del templo. (Para ejemplos de las prohibiciones rituales asociadas con el flujo de sangre en el Antiguo Testamento, ver Levítico 12:2-5 y 15:19). Además, su condición era motivo de gran vergüenza, jpor no hablar de la carga financiera para ella! Sin embargo, desafió las probabilidades y se acercó para "tocar" a Jesús. Y en cuanto a la niña que, por cierto, también fue identificada como de 12 años, fue la fe persistente de su padre – que se opuso a la infidelidad de la multitud – lo que le trajo el "toque" de Jesús, el toque que restaura a una nueva vida.

La mujer que había sufrido mientras vivió esta niña, experimentó la ayuda de Dios, jal igual que la niña! En un período en el que las mujeres y los niños a menudo pasan a un segundo plano, se nos recuerda que nadie es insignificante ante los ojos de Dios. Dios nos ve a todos y sí, conoce nuestras luchas. Nos llama a tener fe y confiar en él, pase lo que pase. Y recuerde, a través de los sacramentos de la Iglesia, experimentamos el toque sanador y la ayuda de nuestro Dios.

Entonces, ya seas tú o alguien a quien quieres que esté pasando por un momento difícil, recuerda esta verdad: "si confías siempre en el Señor, él te hará GUERRERO, no PREOCUPADOR, al enfrentar los desafíos de la vida". ¡Dios lo bendiga!











OCIA AND ADULT CONTINUING FAITH FORMATION
