Our Parish Vacation Bible School was from the 3rd - 7th of June.

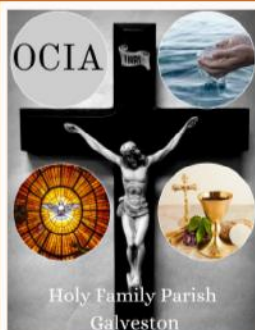
The students were taught the following;

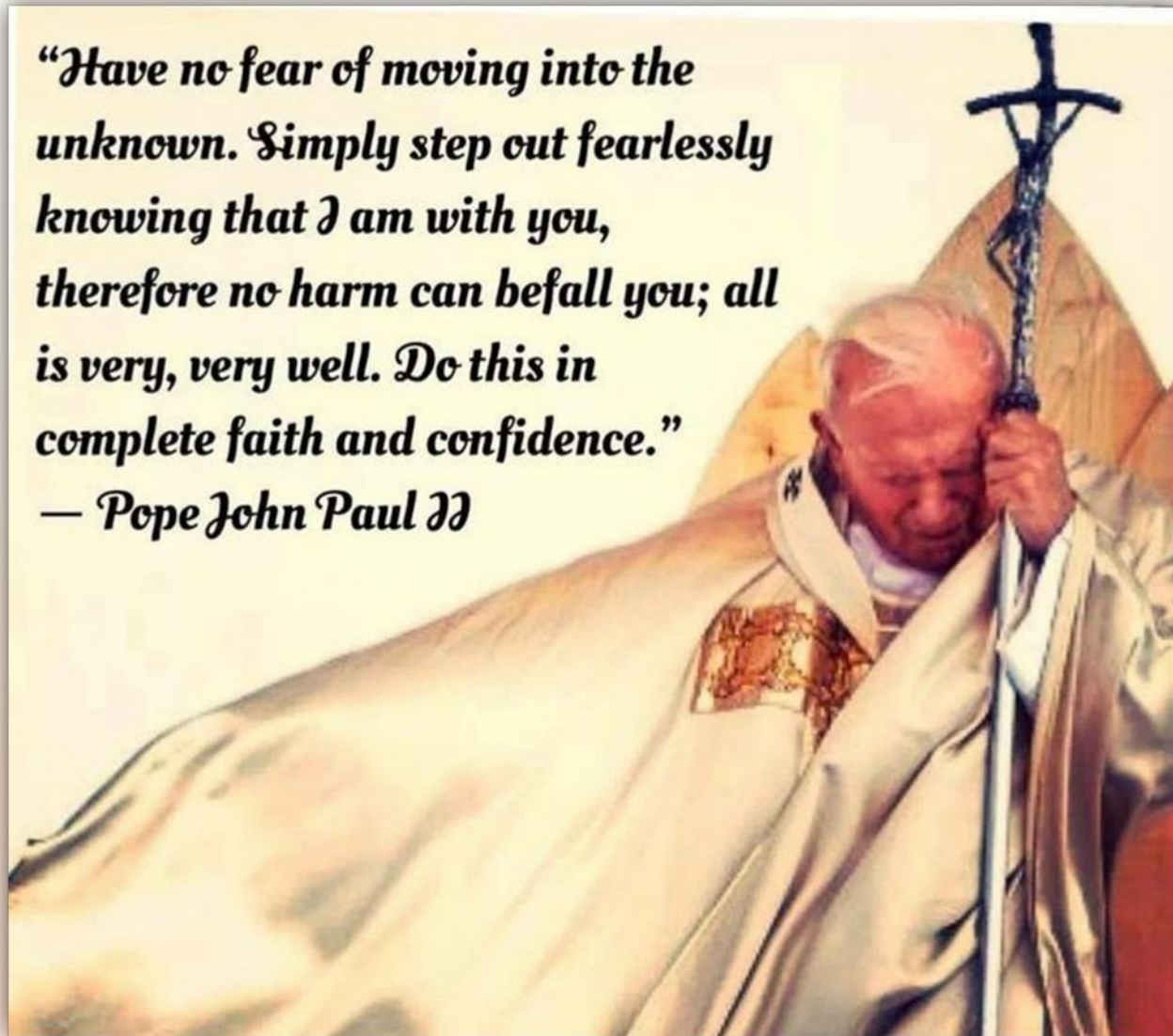
OCIA and Adult Confirmation

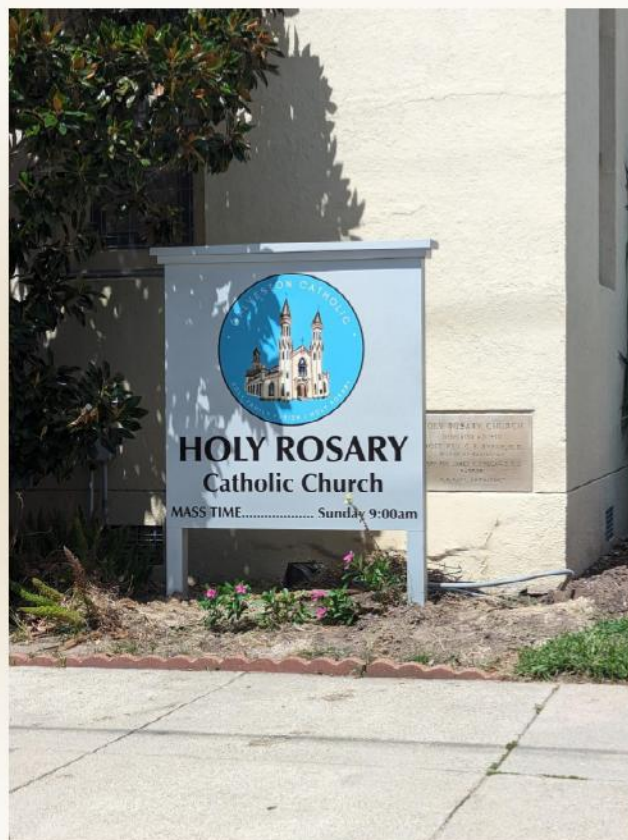
