Message from the Pastor

Mensaje del Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

It was exactly three weeks ago when Hurricane Beryl barreled down upon us with fury, leaving havoc, destruction and all kinds of disruptions. We hope and pray that by now, most of us have recovered well from its aftermath. As we continue the recovery efforts, let us keep in mind our brothers and sisters who might be in need. Knock on a neighbor's door to check on them; it might go a long way.

Beryl, as you would imagine, also impacted the construction project for our new Parish Life Center, causing further delays. As of the time of writing this, we were yet to receive confirmation for the final completion date. At this point, we are taking it one day at a time and hoping that we will be moving into our new Center sooner than later.

Notwithstanding the delays, we cannot overlook the great strides we have made thus far. We were able to weather the challenges posed by the outbreak of the Global Pandemic, which not only pushed back the launch of our ongoing Capital Campaign but also cast a great shadow of doubt on the entire project itself. In addition, the Pandemic also caused a tremendous increase in the cost of construction, which also affected the overall cost of this first phase of our ongoing capital project. In spite of these odds, we persevered and are now only weeks away from moving into the new Parish Life Center.

Thank you for believing and for your great support; without your prayers and generous gifts, we will not be where we are now. But we know that success is ultimately from God. Scripture reminds us that *unless the Lord build the house, in vain do the laborers build* (Psalm 127:1). And God in his loving mercy has blessed our efforts thus far.

This calls our attention to a vital lesson from today's Gospel. Faced with a very challenging situation, the Apostles entrusted the little they had to Jesus – five barley loaves and two fish – and he multiplied their meagre offerings. When we share our resources with our brothers and sisters, entrusting them to the Lord – as we have been doing thus far with our ongoing Capital Campaign project – he blesses them and grants us success.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

En este punto, lo estamos tomando día a día y esperamos mudarnos a nuestro nuevo Centro lo antes posible.

A pesar de los retrasos, no podemos pasar por alto los grandes avances que hemos logrado hasta ahora. Pudimos superar los desafíos planteados por el estallido de la pandemia global, que no solo retrasó el lanzamiento de nuestra campaña de capital en curso, sino que también arrojó una gran sombra de duda sobre todo el proyecto en sí. Además, la pandemia también provocó un enorme aumento en el costo de construcción, lo que también afectó el costo general de esta primera fase de nuestro proyecto de capital en curso. A pesar de estas probabilidades, perseveramos y ahora estamos a solo unas semanas de mudarnos al nuevo Centro de Vida Parroquial.

Gracias por creer y por su gran apoyo; sin sus oraciones y generosos obsequios, no estaremos donde estamos ahora. Pero sabemos que, en última instancia, el éxito proviene de Dios. Las Escrituras nos recuerdan que si el Señor no edifica la casa, en vano edifican los obreros (Salmo 127:1). Y Dios en su amorosa misericordia ha bendecido nuestros esfuerzos hasta ahora.

Esto llama nuestra atención a una lección vital del Evangelio de hoy. Ante una situación muy difícil, los Apóstoles confiaron lo poco que tenían a Jesús –cinco panes de cebada y dos peces– y él multiplicó sus escasas ofrendas. Cuando compartimos nuestros recursos con nuestros hermanos y hermanas, confiándolos al Señor – como lo hemos estado haciendo hasta ahora con nuestro proyecto de Campaña Capital en curso – él los bendice y nos concede el éxito.

Somos: **una Parroquia de la Sagrada** Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!
