Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Throughout this month of August, our Gospel readings will be taken from the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John. We actually began listening to this chapter last weekend with the account of Jesus' miracle of the multiplication of loaves. For the rest of August, Jesus journeys with us as he instructs us about the gift of his body and blood, soul and Divinity, given to us in the Holy Eucharist.

Therefore, each weekend in August, we will focus our attention on a lesson or two about the Holy Eucharist. This weekend, Christ calls us to have faith in the Holy Eucharist. Do we believe in the real presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist or do we simply think that is a mere symbol? In today's Gospel, the people came to look for Christ because he had given them bread to eat. Christ in return challenges and invites them to "not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you." This food is Christ himself in the Holy Eucharist.

And when the people asked Christ in return, "What can we do to accomplish the works of God?" Christ's response is clear and direct: **believe!** "This is the work of God, that you believe in the one he sent." Do you believe in what Christ says to us about the Holy Eucharist namely, that it is his body and blood? This is very crucial – we either believe in the real presence of Christ or not; there is no middle ground!

When we respond "Amen" to the priest or minister at the time of Holy Communion, let us pause and prayerfully reflect on what we are actually saying. It is our acclamation in faith that the Eucharist is truly the body and blood, soul and Divinity of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, under the appearance of bread and wine.

Just as he engaged with his audience in today's Gospel many years ago, Christ dialogues with us today about the gift of himself in the Holy Eucharist. He is the bread of God that comes down from heaven and he says this to you: "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." Do you believe?

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

A lo largo de este mes de agosto, nuestras lecturas del Evangelio estarán tomadas del capítulo sexto del Evangelio de Juan. De hecho, comenzamos a escuchar este capítulo el fin de semana pasado con el relato del milagro de la multiplicación de los panes de Jesús. Durante el resto de agosto, Jesús viaja con nosotros mientras nos instruye sobre el don de su cuerpo y sangre, alma y Divinidad, que se nos da en la Sagrada Eucaristía.

Por lo tanto, cada fin de semana de agosto centraremos nuestra atención en una o dos lecciones sobre la Sagrada Eucaristía. Este fin de semana, Cristo nos llama a tener fe en la Sagrada Eucaristía. ¿Creemos en la presencia real de Cristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía o simplemente pensamos que es un mero símbolo? En el evangelio de hoy, el pueblo vino a buscar a Cristo porque les había dado pan para comer. Cristo, a cambio, los desafía y los invita a "no trabajar por la comida que perece, sino por la comida que permanece para vida eterna, la que os dará el Hijo del Hombre". Este alimento es el mismo Cristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía.

Y cuando la gente le preguntó a Cristo a cambio: "¿Qué podemos hacer para realizar las obras de Dios?" La respuesta de Cristo es clara y directa: ¡cree! "Esta es la obra de Dios: que creáis en el que él envió". ¿Crees en lo que Cristo nos dice sobre la Sagrada Eucaristía, es decir, que es su cuerpo y su sangre? Esto es muy crucial: o creemos en la presencia real de Cristo o no; ¡No hay término medio!

Cuando respondamos "Amén" al sacerdote o ministro en el momento de la Sagrada Comunión, hagamos una pausa y reflexionemos en oración sobre lo que realmente estamos diciendo. Es nuestra aclamación en la fe de que la Eucaristía es verdaderamente cuerpo y sangre, alma y Divinidad de nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo, bajo la apariencia de pan y vino.

Así como habló con su audiencia en el Evangelio de hoy hace muchos años, Cristo dialoga hoy con nosotros sobre el don de sí mismo en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Él es el pan de Dios que desciende del cielo y os dice esto: "Yo soy el pan de vida; el que a mí viene, nunca tendrá hambre, y el que cree en mí, nunca tendrá sed". ¿Tu crees?

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!
