Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Jesus' healing of the deaf man with speech impediment in today's Gospel foreshadows the gift of the sacraments of the Church. They are gifts because they come from Jesus, given to the Church for our salvation. Thus, the sacraments are outward signs of inward grace, instituted by Christ to help us in our spiritual life and to grow in sanctity.

In today's Gospel, there is an emphasis on contact. Jesus "put his finger into the man's ears and, spitting, touched his tongue", we are told. Anyone or anything that comes in contact with the Divine never remains the same; they are transformed as was the case with this man in today's Gospel. The sacraments of the Church puts us in contact with the Lord who heals and strengthens us. And healing, of course, transcends the physical. Take the sacrament of confession for instance, which brings us spiritual healing, restoring us in grace as friends of God.

Christ still walks among us today, and through the Church's sacraments he continues to administer his graces to us. In the Holy Eucharist in particular, he comes to us to feed and nourish us. For the past four weekends we have been listening to the Gospel of John, chapter six, which is centered on the Holy Eucharist. "Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood, you do not have life within you", he tells us plainly. Christ would not have made this requirement if he were not going to provide us with the opportunity to fulfill it.

Christ touched the tongue of the man in need of healing; in the Holy Eucharist, we receive him in our mouth. May we always receive him reverently, and with gratitude, speak with him in our hearts even as we make our way back to our seats. There, in the recesses of our hearts, let us tell him all about our struggles and our joys, and ask him to heal and strengthen us, as he did with the man in today's Gospel.

Christ comes to us always, both in word and in sacrament. He wants to touch our lives and to transform us. Let us receive him with faith and love. However, he chooses to come to you today – through Scriptures, daily interactions with others, at work, in moments of joy and/or trial – dare to welcome him so as to receive his blessings.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

La curación que Jesús hace del hombre sordo con impedimento del habla en el Evangelio de hoy prefigura el don de los sacramentos de la Iglesia. Son dones porque vienen de Jesús, dados a la Iglesia para nuestra salvación. Así, los sacramentos son signos externos de la gracia interna, instituidos por Cristo para ayudarnos en nuestra vida espiritual y crecer en santidad.

En el Evangelio de hoy, se hace hincapié en el contacto. Jesús "metió su dedo en los oídos del hombre y, escupiendo, tocó su lengua", se nos dice. Cualquier persona o cosa que entra en contacto con lo Divino nunca permanece igual; se transforma como fue el caso de este hombre en el Evangelio de hoy. Los sacramentos de la Iglesia nos ponen en contacto con el Señor que nos sana y nos fortalece. Y la curación, por supuesto, trasciende lo físico. Tomemos como ejemplo el sacramento de la confesión, que nos brinda curación espiritual, restableciéndonos en la gracia como amigos de Dios.

Cristo todavía camina entre nosotros hoy, y a través de los sacramentos de la Iglesia continúa administrándonos sus gracias. En la Sagrada Eucaristía, en particular, Él viene a nosotros para alimentarnos y nutrirnos. Durante los últimos cuatro fines de semana hemos estado escuchando el Evangelio de Juan, capítulo seis, que se centra en la Sagrada Eucaristía. "Si no coméis mi carne y bebéis mi sangre, no tenéis vida en vosotros", nos dice claramente. Cristo no habría hecho este requisito si no fuera a darnos la oportunidad de cumplirlo.

Cristo tocó la lengua del hombre que necesitaba curación; en la Sagrada Eucaristía, lo recibimos en nuestra boca. Que siempre lo recibamos con reverencia y con gratitud, hablemos con Él en nuestros corazones incluso cuando regresamos a nuestros asientos. Allí, en lo más profundo de nuestros corazones, contémosle todo sobre nuestras luchas y nuestras alegrías, y pidámosle que nos sane y nos fortalezca, como lo hizo con el hombre del Evangelio de hoy.

Cristo viene a nosotros siempre, tanto en palabra como en sacramento. Quiere tocar nuestras vidas y transformarnos. Recibámoslo con fe y amor. Sin embargo, Él elige venir a ti hoy — a través de las Escrituras, en las interacciones diarias con otros, en el trabajo, en los momentos de alegría y/o prueba — atrévete a darle la bienvenida para recibir sus bendiciones.

Somos: una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!




OCIA and Adult Confirmation




