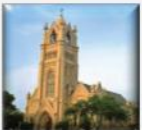

## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This is the last **DSF Commitment Weekend** for this year's Diocesan Services Fund campaign. If you would recall, we launched this year's annual DSF Campaign in the month of February. As I write to you, dearly beloved in Christ, I am reminded of the example of St. Peter Claver, whose feast day we celebrated earlier this week (on September 9th). 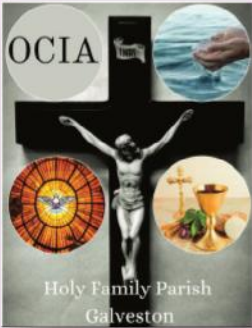

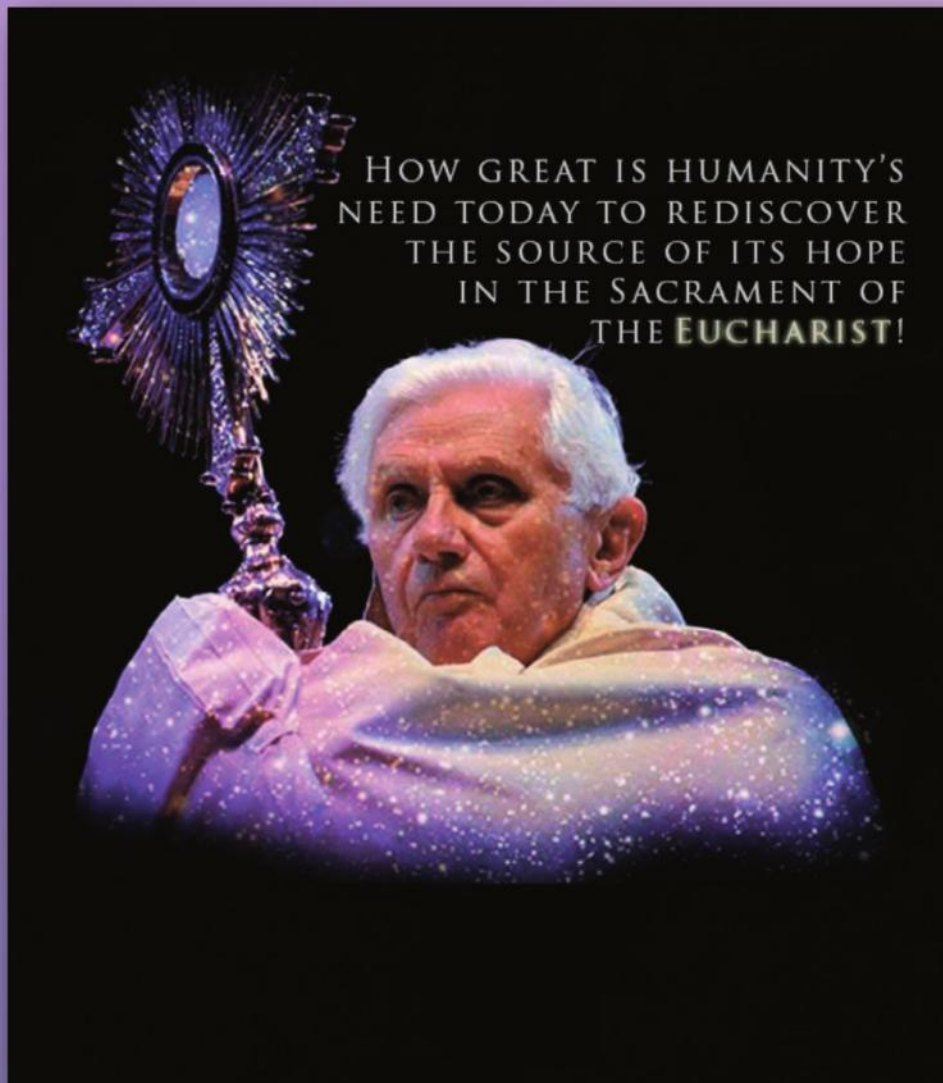




## *OCIA and Adult Confirmation*

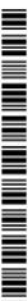

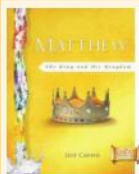

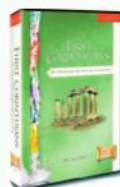
