Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This week's bulletin is a special issue as it contains the **Annual Pastoral and Financial Report**, which covers the fiscal year of **July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024**. As I share with you the following report, I give thanks to God for all his blessings to us, and to you my brothers and sisters, for sharing your blessings of **Time, Talent and Treasure** so generously in support of our Holy Family Parish.

In particular, this year we resume the use of our new **Parish Life Center**, a true labor of love made possible by your generosity and the blessings of God. As the Psalmist reminds us, *unless the Lord build the house, they labor in vain who build* (Psalm 127:1). Our labor of love has borne great fruits thus far because God continues to bless our sacrifices and generosity in support of this project.

The report contained in this week's bulletin covers all donations and gifts received for this past fiscal year ONLY, and how they were disbursed in service of the Gospel and of our parish community. We are still in the closeout phase for the new Parish Life Center, which is **Phase 1** of our multi-phased Capital Campaign initiative – *One Faith, One Family*. As soon as we have the final completion of this first phase, **we will share a follow-up accounting report with details of the full cost of the project as well as the amount of the gifts and donations received.**

The new Center marks a special continuation of the rich legacy of Catholic presence and witness on the island and beyond. Walking the hallways and using the meeting spaces, one gets a sense of connection with the Ursuline sisters who bravely came to the island almost two centuries ago, serving as premier Catholic educators in the state of Texas. Today, our new Center, which once served as the living quarters of the nuns, will now be the space where we pray, fellowship and offer services to our brothers and sisters and to the community as well. May its use always impress upon our hearts and minds that *we are the living temples of God, in which dwells the Spirit of God* (cf. 1 Corinthians 3:16).

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

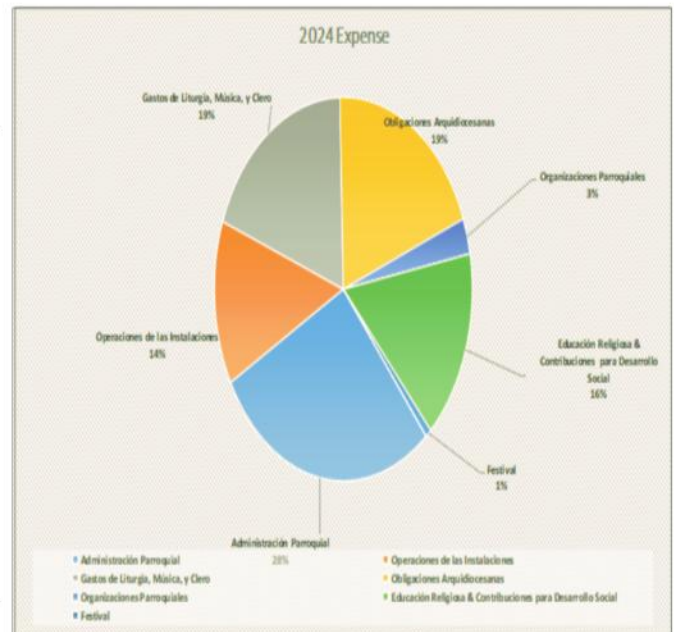
