Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Some of you have been asking me anxiously about when we will be starting the **Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration** at the new **OLG Adoration Chapel**, located at the new Parish Life Center. I am very pleased to announce that it will begin in earnest on the last day of this month – Monday, Sept. 30th. The chapel itself had been ready but we had to wait for the keypad to the door to be installed. All that has been taken care of now and we are ready to go.

At all the Masses this weekend, members of the Evangelization and Stewardship Committee will be addressing us about Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration as well as inviting us to consider signing up as adorers. Our Savior Jesus Christ is truly present in the Holy Eucharist. He waits for you to come and visit. Come as you are and you will experience the healing and comforting presence of the Lord.

Up to this point, we have been having Eucharistic Adoration in the parish from Tuesday morning till Wednesday in the evening. With Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration, anyone can come and be with Jesus who is present in the Holy Eucharist anytime, any day, all year round!

As your pastor, I have been hoping and praying for this and I am so glad that it will finally become a reality in our parish. I hope you will take advantage of this amazing opportunity of grace. Please consider signing up as an adorer. Remember, in order to be able to stop by to visit with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament at any time, you will need an access code, which you can only get by signing up. We are doing this for obvious security reasons so that those who use the chapel in the wee hours of the morning will do so, feeling secured.

In addition to the Eucharistic Adoration, we will also be moving the 7AM daily Mass, as well as Benediction and the 6PM Spanish Mass on Wednesdays from the Our Lady of Guadalupe Chapel to the Ursuline Chapel at the new location effective immediately; please note that the entrance to the Ursuline and Adoration chapels is on 25th street (and NOT on Avenue N). Confessions on Wednesday (4:30-5:30PM) will continue to be held at St. Patrick's Church until further notice.




OCIA AND ADULT CONTINUING FAITH FORMATION
