Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend we celebrate **World Mission Sunday** with our brothers and sisters throughout the world. We are by nature a missionary church to whom the Lord has entrusted the Great Commission to *go, make disciples, teaching them, and baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit* (See: Matthew 28:19-20). The call to missionary engagement is constant and is echoed at the conclusion of each Mass when the minister says to us: *Go, the Mass is ended!*

Those words uttered at the end of the Mass is an invitation to engage in the work of building the kingdom of God. For this year's theme, the Holy Father chose these words of invitation of the Lord, taken from the Gospel of Matthew 2 2:9: **"Go and invite everyone to the banquet"**. To be a faithful disciple of the Lord is to be actively involved in the work of inviting others through the message of the Gospel to share in the life of God.

The flourishing of the faith in our country was made possible through the fervent missionary efforts of those who centuries ago, brought the faith to the shores of this great land. We are called to now support the ongoing missionary efforts of the universal church through our prayers, witness to the faith, as well as our financial contributions.

As the saying goes: *some give to the mission by going; some go to the mission by giving!* Let us give generously to this year's collection for the advancement of the work of proclaiming the Gospel. His Eminence reminds us that the "collection on World Mission Sunday is not merely a conically mandatory tradition, it is a vital lifeline. It supports over 1,150 mission territories in Asia, Africa, Latin America, the Pacific Islands, and the Middle East. Every dollar raised is a testament to our collective commitment to the Great Commission (Cf. Mt 24:19-20). These funds are entirely devoted to evangelization efforts, including the support of seminaries, future religious sisters, catechists, Catholic schools, and healthcare centers that offer life-changing education and care to those most in need".

As you give, remember that we are: **one Holy Family Parish, united with our brothers and sisters everywhere in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

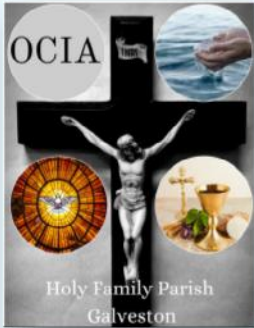

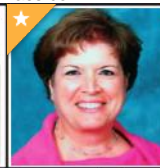
